WHEREAS Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and,

WHEREAS Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and,


WHEREAS Public Safety Telecommunicators of Pickens County have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,

Passed and approved, this 5 day of April, 2021.


