A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE FOR PICKENS COUNTY

WHEREAS, promoting Pickens County's natural, historic, and cultural resources is harmonized with County Council's stated vision to protect and enhance our unique nature; and

WHEREAS, wayfinding signage creates both a safer environment and better experience for citizens and visitors to Pickens County through providing directional information to locations of interest, such as parks and recreational facilities, trails, lake and river access points, museums and historical sites, arts and cultural sites, and county facilities; and

WHEREAS, Pickens County collects an accommodations tax for the purpose of supporting tourism, and is authorized by applicable state law to expend such funds in furtherance of that goal, to include programs such as providing wayfinding signage; and

WHEREAS, Pickens County, with the approval of County Council to utilize a portion of the accommodations tax for a wayfinding signage program for Pickens County, contracted with HDR to develop and implement a wayfinding signage plan; and

WHEREAS, HDR completed the plan with input and assistance from county staff and in accordance with the South Carolina Department of Transportation Traffic Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Pickens County intends to follow the wayfinding signage plan and the criteria and templates described within for all current and future signage projects; and

WHEREAS, all future signs and locations will be determined by the Pickens County Community and Tourism Development Division; and


WHEREAS, Pickens County accepts ownership of and responsibility for future maintenance, repair, and replacement of the wayfinding signage, relieving SCDOT of that responsibility for any and all wayfinding signage installed by Pickens County, according to the wayfinding signage plan, in SCDOT rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, County Council approves the wayfinding signage plan as presented;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Pickens County Council does hereby approve of the wayfinding sign plan as presented and grants approval to advance the project to the installation phase.


