RESOLUTION 2023-29 TO APPOINT CERTAIN COUNTY EMPLOYEES AS COUNTY CONSTABLES PURSUANT TO SECTION 4-9-145 OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code of Laws 4-9-145 empowers County Council to appoint and commission as many code enforcement officers as may be necessary for the proper security, general welfare, and convenience of the county. These officers are vested with all the powers and duties conferred by law upon constables in addition to duties imposed upon them by the governing body of the county; and

WHEREAS, Pickens County Council finds that the appointment of such officers will be good for the health, welfare, and good order of the County and its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the job duties established for the below referenced individual county employees, and subject to the limitations also referenced hereinafter;

Michael D. Todd	Environmental Enforcement	County-wide for all building codes, stormwater, development standards, litter, solid waste and property conditions
Stuart C. Simmons	Environmental Enforcement	County-wide for all building codes, stormwater, development standards, litter, solid waste and property conditions
Marcus D. Vincent	Environmental Enforcement	County-wide for all building codes, stormwater, development standards, litter, solid waste and property conditions

BE IT RESOLVED that Pickens County Council does hereby appoint the preceding employees as County Constables pursuant to Section 4-9-145 of the South Carolina Code of Laws
