WHEREAS, the Congress and President of the United States have designated May 15 as Peace Officers Memorial Day; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Pickens County Sheriff's Office play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the citizens of our community; and


WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and understand the duties, responsibilities, hazards and sacrifices of their law enforcement officers, and that law enforcement officers recognize their duty to serve the people of this County, by protecting them against violence and disorder; and

WHEREAS, the law enforcement officers of the Pickens County Sheriff's Office unceasingly provide a vital public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Council of the County of Pickens directs that all flags on County buildings be flown at half-staff on May 15, 2024, in recognition of Peace Officers Memorial Day and in memory of those law enforcement officers, who through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their communities or have become disabled in the performance of duty, and to honor those law enforcement officers presently serving all communities.
