

## Meeting Minutes August 2021

Matthew has completed Land Application for the Upper and Roper plants and is now at the Central North Plant, unfortunately it will take us an additional 2 or 3 weeks to be done with the Middle Plant. Nick Banks joined us on Monday and he's been riding with Josh on his rounds, so he's already taken the chore of signing off on the log books. Right now he's tracking down numbers for a number of parts and valves.

Les Hendrix is with us today and we're going to talk about the proposal of the town of Central's plan to take over the Grange project's collection system.

The group discusses the move to executive session.

The commission comes out of Executive Session.

The table seems to agree that the town of Central is the best option.

Clint: And Central isn't going to leave in the Middle of the night.

Connie: They'll be ready before the project starts.

Ratner: I see why Central wants this and think it's the best option we have today. They don't have to worry about lawsuits because Condor let it fall into disrepair.

Connie: I think we can make a recommendation to County Council that Central takes over the project.

Ratner: I'll make that motion.

Connie: I'll second that motion. Any further discussion? All in favor say Aye.

The motion passes unanimously.

Les: I'll write a letter summarizing what this proposal is. Are we talking about the 200 houses?

Connie: I proposed the entire sewer system as a part of the recommendation

Clint: This is just a recommendation to County Council, who will then have to formulate a resolution.

Connie: Anything else for our consideration?

Clint: If you guys want to talk about changing the date of our next meeting we can do that right now.  
Can everybody make it one the 20<sup>th</sup>?

The table agrees to the 20<sup>th</sup>

Connie: Any further movements?

Ratner: I move we adjourn.
