The proposed agreements have been approved by the Cities and set forth the services that will be provided by Pickens County. The County Attorney has reviewed and approved the content of the agreement. Approval of the proposed agreement is recommended.

A grant application has been prepared and with Council's approval will be submitted to the South Carolina Arts Commission for funding in the amount of \$5,250.00 to assist with the 2004 Pickens County Upcountry Folklife Festival, which is held at the Hagood Mill Site. The grant requires an equal match of \$5,250.00, which is generated by gate revenues on the day of the Festival. Council approval is recommended.
