Consideration of a proposed resolution to name the terminal building and any future terminal buildings at the Pickens County Airport after Herbert Jones. Mr. Jones was the first pilot to land at the Pickens County Airport in 1967 and served on the Pickens County Aeronautics Commission for 37 years.

Consideration to provide directive to Animal Control Task Force on a date to submit a report to County Council. County Council created an Animal Control Task Force in 2004 to review animal control and adoption issues and to develop recommendations for County Council's consideration. Direction needs to be provided to the Task Force on when Council would like to have their recommendations.

Consideration of a request from Sheriff Stone for approval to apply for a grant to fund a narcotics officer. The total amount needed in the first year is \$112,000 of which \$84,000 would be grant funds and \$28,000 would be county match funds. The match requirements would not be needed until fiscal year 2005/2006.
