May 1940

Hon. W. G. Haddow, County Judge and Pension Administrator, addressed the Board on matters pertaining to the proposed Pension Department of Ordinance. The following Ordinance was adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 1

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Pierce, Does Ordain:

SECTION 1: There is hereby created a committee to consist of three (3) members of this board of supervisors, which committee shall be known as the "Pierce County Security Aid Committee".

SECTION 2: Members of this committee shall be appointed by the chairman of the board for a term of one year. Vacancies on the committee shall be filled as other vacancies are filled on committees created under Section 59.06 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3: Members of the security aid committee shall receive the same per diem and mileage as other members of the County Board committees created pursuant to Section 59.06 of the Wis. Statutes.

SECTION 4: Upon the organization of the committee, the County Clerk shall notify the state department of Public Welfare of such organization and give the names and addresses of its officers.

SECTION 5: Meetings shall be held upon the call of the chairman:

SECTION 6: The committee shall represent the County Board in all matters relating to the administration of the social security aids with-in the County, except that its powers and duties shall be advisory on matters of policy and not administrative or executive.

The committee shall act as the appointing authority as provided by the rules and regulations of the State Department of Public Welfare, and employees shall be selected by the judge with the advice & consent of the committee upon certification by the state bureau of personnel.

Upon recommendation of the judge and subject to the regulations of the state department of public welfare, the committee shall fix salaries within the ranges set for the various classes of positions.

SECTION 7: To the end that the County may receive federal and state aid, the committee shall observe all lawful rules and regulations of the state department of public welfare.

SECTION 8: The provisions of this ordinance shall supersede any inconsistent provisions of any other ordinance or resolution relating to the subject matter of this ordinance.

SECTION 9: The County Clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the division of public assistance of the state department of public welfare a certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
