The Budget Hearing meeting was called to order by Chair, LeRoy Peterson at 7:00pm. Joe Rohl went over proposed budget with those in attendance. Public Safety account higher due to Clifton's portion of the proposed fire truck purchase in 2022 by Prescott Fire and EMS.
