

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-1

Ordinance to Designate Class "B" Highways

**STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of El Paso
Pierce County**

The Town Board of the Town of El Paso, Pierce County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15(2), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of El Paso, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate town highways as Class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of El Paso as designated Class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set for in s. 348.16(2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance: all town highways.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16(2), Wis. Stats. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective on December 1, 2007.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
