

**AMEND BEER AND LIQUOR LICENSE FEES  
ORDINANCE 2020-2  
Town of Ellsworth**

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Emergency Order #5 ordered a moratorium of all gatherings of 10 or more people to mitigate the spread of Covid 19, and

WHEREAS, effective at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 17, all restaurants and bars were ordered closed , and

WHEREAS, on March 23<sup>rd</sup>, a guidance document was released stating “Class B” license holders may sell alcoholic beverages in the original, sealed container on a carry-out basis only, and only where permitted by local ordinance patrons may enter the establishments only for the purpose of picking up and paying for food and beverages, and

WHEREAS, the Pierce County Tavern League has appealed to municipalities to help the small bars and restaurants for the license period July 1, 2020-June 30, 2021 by lowering the liquor “Class B” license fee to minimum amount of \$50 and waive the fee for Class “B” beer license, and

WHEREAS, the municipality has the right to set the fee for beer and liquor licenses,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that for the licensing period of July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021, the Town of Ellsworth hereby establishes the Class “B” beer license fee to be \$75 and the “Class B” liquor license fee to be \$375, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this fee is only for the July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 license period, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Section 3 FEES of the Town of Ellsworth Intoxicating Beverages and Liquor Ordinance 1996-1 be amended for the July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 license period as follows:

SECTION 3. FEES

(b) Class “B” Retail License fermented malt beverage	\$ 80.00
“Class B” Retail License intoxicating liquor	\$ 400.00

Adopted this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020 at properly noticed meeting of the Ellsworth Town Board with a roll call vote.


