

**Resolution No. 2021-3**

**RESOLUTION TO ADJUST THE WARD BOUNDARIES  
IN THE TOWN OF ELLSWORTH**

**WHEREAS**, per Wis. Stats. 59.10(3)(b)(1) Pierce County has submitted a tentative plan to the Town of Ellsworth for the creation of county supervisory districts that are substantially equal in population based on the 2020 census;

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stats. 5.15(1) provides for the division of a municipality into wards; and

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stats 5.15(2)(b) provides that population of a ward shall not contain more than 1,000 inhabitants; and

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stats 5.15(4)(a) states the division resolution shall number all wards in the municipality beginning with number one, and shall describe the boundaries of each ward;, and

**WHEREAS**, the polling place is to be located in Ward 1;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Ward 1 of the Town of Ellsworth be all of the Town of Ellsworth except all that part of the Town of Ellsworth lying west and north of the following boundary line: Commencing on Highway 10 on the boundary line between the Village of Ellsworth and Town of Ellsworth in Section 17, thence continue northerly on said boundary line to 670<sup>th</sup> Street, continue north on 670<sup>th</sup> Street to 610<sup>th</sup> Avenue, thence east on 610<sup>th</sup> Avenue a distance of 1 ½ miles to 610<sup>th</sup> Street, thence north on 610<sup>th</sup> Street a distance of 1 mile to County Rd N and end of said boundary line. Said Ward 2 includes all of Sections 4, 5, and 6, the N ¼ of Section 7 except what is in the Village of Ellsworth, all lands belonging to the Ellsworth Country Club in Section 7 lying north of 580<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and the West ½ of Section 8 lying north of 580<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Ward 2 of the Town of Ellsworth be that part of the Town of Ellsworth lying west and north of the following boundary line: Commencing on Highway 10 on the boundary line between the Village of Ellsworth and Town of Ellsworth in Section 17, thence continue northerly on said boundary line to 670<sup>th</sup> Street, continue north on 670<sup>th</sup> Street to 610<sup>th</sup> Avenue, thence east on 610<sup>th</sup> Avenue a distance of 1 ½ miles to 610<sup>th</sup> Street, thence north on 610<sup>th</sup> Street a distance of 1 mile to County Rd N and end of said boundary line. Said Ward 2 includes all of Sections 4, 5, and 6, the N ¼ of Section 7 except what is in the Village of Ellsworth, all lands belonging to the Ellsworth Country Club in Section 7 lying north of 580<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and the West ½ of Section 8 lying north of 580<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Wards 1 and 2 be combined for reporting election results, except for the election of County Board Supervisors; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the designated polling place is at St. Paul's United Church of Christ Church, W5706 State Road 72, Ellsworth, WI.
