

Town of Gilman  
Monthly Meeting Minutes  
March 16, 2022

1. Meeting called to order by Chair Verges at 7:00 pm
2. **Roll call:** Chair Verges, Supervisor Traynor, Supervisor Emerson, Treasurer Emerson and Clerk Manley. Also attending: Tana & John Shingler, Dennis Mack, Paula Lugar, David Larson and Dewey Anderson.
3. **Pledge is recited**
4. **Minutes:** Motion by Mike, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill to approve minutes of 2/9/22 meeting; motion carried.
5. **Bills:** Motion by Bill, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike to approve bills with the addition of a bill from Martell township; motion carried.
6. **Treasurer's report:** Beginning balance: \$890,501.13 income: \$188,617.10 Expense: \$740,996.18 ending balance: \$338,122.05 including \$252,588.41 in available funds and \$32,920.31 in savings. ARPA savings balance: \$52,613.33
7. **Operator's permits:** Motion by Mike, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill to approve one for Team Travel; motion approved.
8. **Public comments:** Paula Lugar introduced herself and talked about her candidacy for County Supervisor, a role she has had for 4 years. Dave Larson asked about speed limits on Highway 29 between 450<sup>th</sup> and N. He said speeding is a concerning issue for the residents on that stretch of substantially populated road.
9. **Hall rental:** The topic of possibly renting the hall for private events was discussed and tabled pending further research.
10. **BIL grants:** Dennis Mack from Cedar Corp. provided details regarding the process of applying for the available infrastructure grants being offered by the federal government. Motion by Mike, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill to approve Gilman starting the process to apply for said money; motion carried.
11. **All Croix:** Todd Dolan explained the proposed renewal of the contract we currently have with All Croix and amendments proposed to to the Building Inspector Ordinance. Motion by Bill, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike to approve the All Croix contract through March of 2024; motion approved. Motion by Mike, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill to adopt the amended Building Inspector Ordinance; motion approved.
12. **Roads:** Dewey thanked the board and clerk for the new phone, which he is learning to love. Weight limit signs are up on the township roads. They will be removed at the patrolman's discretion. Dewey discussed a project that the county is doing this summer on 850<sup>th</sup> & B which he would like the town take part in.
13. **Chair's report:** Phil has spoken to our attorney regarding a noisy dog complaint. The annual spring Big Dumpster Days will be May 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>. The board and patrolman will conduct the road tour on March 22<sup>nd</sup> and details will be shared at the annual meeting which is April 19<sup>th</sup>.
