

Hartland Regular Town Board Meeting March 14, 2023 at 7:00pm

Hartland Town meeting was called into session at 7:02pm by Chairman Kurt Nelson. In attendance – Kurt, Cyndi, Polly, Mark, RJ, Don M, 5 residents/guests.

The **minutes** of the February board meeting were presented by the clerk. Motion made by Girdeen to accept minutes with minor corrections as noted, seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

Monthly bills were presented. Girdeen made a motion to accept and pay all bills. Motion seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

The **Treasurer's Report** – showed \$478,643.74 in the checking account. Total funds available \$478,643.74 less equipment outlay of \$43,903.67, road expense of \$256,636.97, Local Recovery Fund of \$90,747.64 and EI Grant of \$400 for an adjusted balance of \$86,955.46.

A motion was made by Girdeen to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

RJ Duden's road and road work report

- Lots more plowing and sanding for Matt and RJ. Plenty of snow/rain/ice in the last month.
 - Replaced the spinner motor on the Sterling.
 - Replaced 2 more hydraulic lines on the Peterbuilt.
 - The patcher needed some wiring fixed for the safety beacon.
 - Replacing old/damaged road signs between snow storms.
 - Tree is still on schedule to be removed from the creek.
 - Starting on a list of snow equipment in need of repair/replacement during the offseason.
 - The wood pile was burned at the recycling center. The scrap pile has not grown much over the winter months, plan to let residents finish their spring cleaning before arranging for its removal.
 - Weight restriction signs have been posted as of 3/14.
 - Filter sale is on right now at Auto Value, plan to stock up on needed filters for future use.
 - The wellhead for the shop was clipped with a plow. It sustained minor damage. Hoyer has been notified and will be fixing when possible.
 - The salt/sand pile is pretty well used up. Shouldn't be any issues using what's left before the state does their inspection.

The clerk distributed a draft of the ATV Ordinance with revisions. This will be a discuss and take action item on the April agenda.

New Business

590th Street. Virgil Weberg is requesting the road be blacktopped. Very soft. Usually the county preps the road before the blacktop is laid. Chair Nelson explained that the town is likely not in a position to do any blacktopping until the bridge projects are done. And is not included in the five-year plan.
