## ORDINANCE NO.: //

The Town Board of the Town of Trenton, Pierce County, Wisconsin ordains as follows:

- A. OPERATOR'S LICENSE. Required. No premises operated under a Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B" or "Class C" alcohol beverage license or permit may be open for business, unless there is upon the premises the licensee or permittee, the agent named in the license or permit if the licensee or permittee is a corporation or some person who has an operator's license and who is responsible for the acts of all persons serving any fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors to customers.
- B. Application and Fee. The Town Board may issue a license known as an "Operator's" license which may be granted only upon application in writing on a form prescribed by the Town Board.
- C. <u>Requirements</u>. The applicant must meet the following requirements.
  - 1. Be at least 18 years of age.
- 2. Have fully and honestly completed the information requirements of the application form and paid the required fee. The fee must be paid at the time of application.
- 3. Have successfully completed a responsible beverage server training course at any location it is offered by a vocational, technical and adult education district that conforms to curriculum guidelines specified by the Board of Vocational, Technical and Adult Education or unless the application fulfills one of the following requirements:
  - a) The person is renewing an operator's license.
- b) Within the past two years, the person held a Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B" or "Class C" license or permit or a manager's or operator's license.
- c) Within the past two years, the person has completed such a training course.
- 4. Have paid an initial two year fee of \$20.00 and/or a two year renewal fee of \$10.00.
- 5. Shall not have a conviction or arrest record, subject to the provisions of <u>Wis. Stat.</u> §111.321, §111.322 and §111.335. The applicant shall provide a signed notarized release authorizing release of all arrest, conviction, or any other criminal records regarding the applicant.
  - D. Additional information. The Town Board may require the

applicant to provide any additional information that the Town Board deems necessary or helpful in determining whether the applicant meets the requirements for holding an operator's license.

- E. <u>Provisional Operator's License</u>. Pursuant to <u>Wis</u>. <u>Stat</u>. §125.17 (5) the Town Board may issue a provisional operator's license.
  - 1. Requirements.
- a) A provisional operator's license may only be issued to a person who has applied for an operator's license under this ordinance.
- b) The applicant must provide all information required under this ordinance and state statutes for an operator's license.
- c) The applicant must provide proof that he/she is registered for the next available responsible beverage server training course offered within a 100 mile radius of the Town of Trenton.
- d) The applicant must pay an application fee of \$15.00 for a provisional operator's license. This fee is non-refundable and is in addition to the operator's license application fee.
- e) Within one day after the responsible beverage server training course in which the applicant is enrolled is offered, the applicant shall file with the Town Clerk proof that the applicant has successfully completed the responsible beverage server training class.
- f) Any applicant who does not successfully complete the next available responsible beverage server training course shall not qualify for another provisional operator's license.
- 2. Expiration. The provisional operator's license expires 60 days after its issuance or when an operator's license is issued by the Town Board or when the Town Board receives notification that the applicant has not successfully completed the responsible beverage server course in which he or she is enrolled.
- 3. <u>Revocation</u>. The Town Board shall revoke a provisional operator's license if the applicant fails to complete the responsible beverage server training course in which he or she is enrolled.
- F. Statutes Adopted. The provisions of Chapter 125 regulating the sale, procurement, dispensing of alcohol beverages are hereby adopted and made a part of this section by reference. A violation of any of such provisions or any ordinance adopted by the Town Board relating to the sale dispensing, procurement of

alcohol beverages shall constitute a violation of this section.
G. Revocation. Any violation of the terms of this section shall be cause for revocation of such license.
