### ADOPTING THE PIERCE COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

**FISCAL IMPACT:** None

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Trenton recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

**WHEREAS**, under taking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Trenton participated jointly in the planning process with Pierce County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Board of the Township of Trenton, hereby adopts the Pierce County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Pierce County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Township, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes been made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
