**PRACTICES ELIGIBLE FOR COST SHARING**

The Pierce County Land Conservation Committee shall consider cost sharing assistance for any practices listed in ATCP50 Subchapter VIII – Standards for Cost-Shared Practices. Ranking of practices will be consistent with the current Pierce County Land and Water Resource Management Plan. Actual ranking criteria used may be subject to change to address work plan priorities as approved by the Land Conservation Committee. Cost sharing will be consistent with ATCP 50.40.

Applicants must consent to a NR151 Agricultural Performance Standards and Prohibitions inventory on the tax parcel in which cost sharing is being requested.

All NR151 prohibition violations (NR151.08) must be properly addressed prior to receiving cost sharing for the requested practice.

NR 151.08 Manure Management Prohibitions, All livestock producers must comply with:

1. No overflow of manure storage structures
2. No unconfined manure piles in water quality management areas
3. No direct runoff from a feedlot or stored manure into water of the state.
4. No unlimited livestock access to water of the state where high concentrations of animals prevent adequate sod cover.

**I agree to maintain the conservation practice throughout its normal life span as long as the land is under my control. Failure to maintain the practice shall be cause for proper maintenance to be performed by the Department at my expense. I further agree to participate in an NR151 Agricultural Performance standards and prohibitions evaluation with LCD personnel on the land in which cost sharing is being requested.**
