ORDINANCE NO. 66

Ordinance to Sell Old Age Assistance Property --
The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Pierce do Ordain :

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Sec. 49.26(4), Wisconsin Statutes, as amended by Ch. 522, Laws of 1943, the Committee provided by the County Board for the sale of tax deeded lands of this county is authorized and empowered to acquire and dispose of property for the purpose of liquidating old age assistance liens. All properties owned or controlled by this, Committee under this ordinance are to be listed for sale semi-annually in June and December in all newspapers in the County qualified to publish legal notices.

SECTION 2: The provisions of this ordinance shall supersede any inconsistent provision of any other ordinance or resolution relating to the subject matter of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: The County Clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the Division of Public Assistance of the State Department of Public Welfare a certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.

We hereby recommend the adoption of the above resolution.
