DANCE & AMUSEMENT ORDINANCE

The board of Supervisors of Pierce County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1 - No person shall hold or conduct a public dance or operate a resort or place of amusement within the County of Pierce outside of the limits of an incorporated city of village without having first procured a license so to do so as hereinafter provided.

(a) LICENSES. Application for a Dance and Amusement license shall be made in writing in a form prescribed by the Pierce County Board of Supervisors signed by the owner or tenant of the place or space sought to be licensed, showing among other things that the applicant has not been convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of Wisconsin or the United States, and that applicant is eligible to vote within the territorial confines of Pierce County, Wisconsin, and in the event of a corporation applicant, such recital shall be necessary as to all officers and directors thereof. Such application shall be filed with the County Clerk. Such said application shall be submitted to the Dance Hall committee for approval or disapproval. Such said Committee acting with the Chairman of the County Board shall issue or deny license. No such license issued shall be transferable either as to place or person. Any license issued pursuant to this ordinance shall expire on the 30th day of June next following the date of issue unless previously revoked.

(b) FEE. There shall be a license issued pursuant to this ordinance to be designated a Dance and Amusement license. Such license shall permit the holder

thereof to conduct public dancing, roller skating, and to hold out to the public for amusement and not excluding by reason of enumeration, shuffle board, pin ball, "Juke Box", and other similar mechanical contrivances. The fee therefore shall be \$50.00 annually. It shall be the duty of the County Clerk upon his issuance of such license to supply therewith a copy of this ordinance.

Section 2 - Dance Hall Committee. The Chairman of the County Board shall annually appoint a committee of three members to act as a Dance Hall Committee. It shall be the duty of the Dance Hall Committee to inspect all licenses hereunder three times annually to determine the mode of conduct of such licensed premises, and to conduct similar inspection of such places within the County not licensed to determine whether or not there is a violation of this ordinance, and to report any violations to the District Attorney for prosecutions. Such Committee shall have the duty of investigating applicants for license, and to approve or disapprove the application therefore, and in conjunction with the Chairman of the County Board, to issue these approved. It shall be a further duty of such Committee to render an annual report of its inspection to the County Board. It shall be a further duty of the Dance Hall Committee to make available when required by law a Dance supervisor such appointment to be discretionary with said Committee.

Section 3. - All fees provided herein shall be paid into the County Treasurer, and all expenses of administering this ordinance shall be paid from the Dance

Hall License fund. Expenses and per diem of members of the Committee reasonably incurred in the performances of their duties shall be authorized as provided for by County Board, and paid from the aforementioned Fund.

Section 4. - All Statutes of the State of Wisconsin bearing or touching upon regulation of Dances and Amusement places are hereby incorporated by reference with the same force and effect as if set forth in full herein and a violation of any such Statute shall be a violation of this Ordinance and make the violator liable to forfeiture as hereinafter set forth.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a forfeiture of not less than Fifty Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars, together with the cost of prosecution, and in default in payment thereof shall be confined in the County Jail for a period not to exceed Sixty days. Conviction for such violation shall revoke the license issued hereunder, and no application shall be considered for new license within three months of the date of conviction.

Section 6. - The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and invalidity of any part shall not affect the other provisions. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7. - Upon passage and publication this ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 1956.
