

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PINCKNEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL

HELD MONDAY, JUNE 25, 2018 AT 6:00 P.M.

IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL

ROLL CALL

Mayor Robert L. Spencer called the regular meeting of the Pinckneyville City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall. Members present: Commissioners Kevin B. Hicks, Sammy D. Peradotta, David M. Stone, William B. Stotlar, and Mayor Robert L. Spencer. Mayor Spencer declared a quorum present. Mayor Spencer then announced the agenda was set. Administrative staff present: City Clerk Lawrence S. West, City Attorney Donald Bigham, Police Chief John Griffin and Fire Chief Jim Gielow. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Sammy D. Peradotta.

PREVIOUS MINUTES

Commissioner Hicks made a motion to approve the previous minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stone. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Commissioner Stotlar stated that total payroll is \$9,072.43 higher than last year. Payroll hours are 499.81 hours lower than last year. Overtime hours are 141.50 hours lower than last year. Commissioner Stotlar made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Peradotta. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

Commissioner Stotlar made a motion to approve accounts payable. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stone. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

Commissioner Peradotta reported that the city was going to oil and chip certain streets on June 25-27, 2018 but that has been delayed by weather concerns. The new dates for oil and chipping will be July 2, 3, and 5, 2018. Also, the city originally was going to oil and chip Imperial Heights but residents in that area did not want that to happen.

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-20

Commissioner Peradotta made a motion to place on file Resolution No. R-2018-20, a resolution for improvement under the Illinois Highway Code. This resolution is the result of a Motor Fuel Tax audit and it establishes a section code with the Illinois Department of Transportation. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stotlar. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-21

Commissioner Peradotta introduced Resolution No. 2018-21, a resolution to be placed on file authorizing the City of Pinckneyville, Perry County, Illinois to enter into a mowing contract with James L. Heller and Scott E Heller, d/b/a J & S Services. He explained that this contract would include new areas of mowing at: the hospital lot (when purchased by the City), 108 E. Hawkins St., Imperial Heights, Cedar Point, and Blue Bunting to State Route 154. He received three bids and J & S was much lower than the other two. Commissioner Peradotta made a motion to place on file Resolution No. R-2018-21. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stone. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

REQUEST TO PURCHASE MATERIALS

Commissioner Peradotta said that materials are needed to be purchased for the Fallon Street storm sewer project. He said the engineers said the city will need two cleanouts for the project to meet code. The manholes will cost \$2,918.00 and will be

acquired from County Materials Corporation in Charleston, Illinois. Commissioner Peradotta made a motion to approve request. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Stotlar. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-19

Commissioner Stone made a motion to approve Resolution No. R-2018-19, a resolution placed on file at the June 11, 2018 city council meeting authorizing termination of sales agreement and agreement to develop real estate within the Pinckneyville Business District with Leigh Blackorby. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hicks. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.
