

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE PINCKNEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL

ROLL CALL

Mayor Robert L. Spencer called the regular meeting of the Pinckneyville City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall. Members present: Commissioners Kevin B. Hicks, Sammy D. Peradotta, David M. Stone, William B. Stotlar, and Mayor Robert L. Spencer. Mayor Spencer declared a quorum present. There were no changes to the agenda and Mayor Spencer announced the agenda was set. Peradotta.

Motion was made by Commissioner Stone to approve the minutes of the September 9, 2018 meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hicks. On roll call: Commissioners Hicks, Peradotta, Stone, Stotlar, and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.

APPROVAL OF ALL CLASS A LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENTS REMAIN OPEN

Motion by Commissioner Hicks, seconded by Commissioner Stotlar to approve all Class A liquor establishments to be open until 2:00 a.m. on the dates of October 26 & 27, 2018 and also to be open until 2:00 a.m. on New Year's Eve December 31, 2018 (until 2:00 a.m. January 1, 2019). DELTA THETA TAU COLLECION

Motion by Commissioner Hicks, seconded by Commissioner Stotlar to approve the request from Delta Theta Tau for collection of funds around the square and four-way stop on November 10, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. until noon. This has been done the past three years. Commissioner Peradotta suggested orange vests be worn. He also offered safety cones for use. LIONS CLUB DONATION
