

**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PINCKNEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL
HELD MONDAY, APRIL 26, 2021 FOR THE ANNUAL BUDGET AT 5:45 P.M.
IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL**

ROLL CALL

Mayor Robert L. Spencer called the public hearing for the annual budget of the Pinckneyville City Council to order at 5:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall.
