

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE PINCKNEYVILLE CITY COUNCIL

LOCK GAS RATES FOR FUTURE GAS PURCHASES FROM INTERSTATE MUNICIPAL GAS AGENCY

Commissioner Stotlar made a motion to lock in gas rates for future gas purchases from Interstate Municipal Gas Agency for additional 25% volumes for Winter 2021/2022 and Winter 2022/2023 and for 75% volumes for Winter 2023/2024, Winter 2024/2025, Winter 2025/2026, Winter 2026/2027, and Winter 2027/2028. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Peradotta. On roll call: Commissioners Cicardi, Hicks, Peradotta, Stotlar and Mayor Spencer voted YEA. NAYS: None. Motion declared carried.
