The public may submit Public Comments prior to the City Council Meeting by written submission delivered to the City Clerk's Office or e-mail at cityclerk@pinckneyvillecity.com. Written or e-mailed Public Comments must be received by **4:00 p.m.** on the day of the meeting and will be read during the Public Comment section of the meeting.

To have a specific matter placed on the meeting agenda, a member of the public requesting an addition to the agenda should contact the City Clerk at least five (5) days prior to the Council meeting and provide the City Clerk with sufficient information to allow the City Clerk to determine the nature of the agenda item. The Council requests that members of the public avoid repetitive appearances before the Council with the same issue. Comments should be limited to approximately five (5) minutes. Groups who wish to address the Council on the same or similar issues should select a spokesman to present the concerns of the group members.
