YOU MAY APPLY DURING OR ANY TIME AFTER YOUR PRIORITY PERIOD:

OCTOBER: ELDERLY (OVER 60), DISABLED (NEED PROOF OF DISABILITY) AND/OR HOUSEHOLD WITH CHILDREN UNDER 6 YRS. OLD (BRING PROOF OF CHILD'S AGE)

NOVEMBER: HOUSEHOLDS THAT ARE DISCONNECTED OR HAVE A DISCONNECT NOTICE (DISCONNECTION NOTICE IS NEEDED) PLUS ELDERLY, DISABLED AND HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN UNDER 6 YRS. OLD

DECEMBER: OPEN ENROLLMENT TO INCLUDE ALL THE ABOVE AND ALL INCOME ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS.

Program runs through to August 15, 2024 (or until funds are exhausted)

Customers must provide copies of their gas and/or electric bills and copies of all household members' Social Security cards & 30-day proof of income; if no income you can still apply.

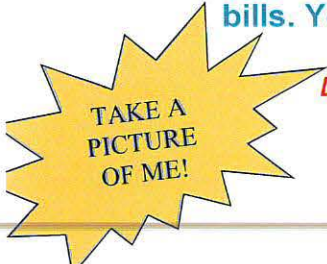
Jackson Office located in Murphysboro: Monday - Friday 8:00-4:30
