

Tony Grelli – Velocity 55 Industrial Park

Councilman Fitzpatrick introduced Tony Grelli of Velocity 55 Industrial Park. Tony Grelli presented a PowerPoint presentation and spoke of the improvements being done to the industrial park located at 410-450 Andbro Drive.

4 Way Stop – Carew and Centre

Councilwoman Milward started the conversation regarding a 4 way stop at Carew and Centre because of the dinosaur trail that is trying to connect to Carew. Chief McAteer reported that there have been some high speeds in that area and with the bike trail coming, it would be a good time to look at that intersection closer. Councilman Mazzola spoke of a blind bend in that area too.

Councilwoman Milward continued with the request of (1) 15-minute parking sign in front of Rose Bud Florist as well as updated signs in front of the post office. The Chief offered to do an audit of all the parking signs and report back to Council.

Mayor Razze mentioned the yellow curb at the Presbyterian Church and how this area should be added to the parking ordinance as well.

Water Credit - 103 First Avenue

Councilman Kelly explained that the resident at 103 First Avenue is looking for relief from their sewer bill. It seems the resident was away for work and the pipe broke. The amount of relief is \$394.20. Councilman Fitzpatrick asked if the system could flag these high usages in a timelier manner. Councilman Kelly answered unfortunately not.
