Current Programs/Events:

- Travel basketball registrations are still open. Tonight is the last night for evaluations for the boys' teams. Practices will begin the first week in December. Games will be played on Saturday and Sundays starting in late December until February.
- On November 14, 21, and 28, there will be multiple basketball programs taking place. For grades 3-6, there will be both an open gym along with a skills/drill tune up program. These signups are available online but only have limited spots. Additionally, there will also be an open gym for grades 7 and 8.
- Because the high school gym floors are being resurfaced, the pickleball program had to end a few sessions shorter than planned.
- Leaf cleanup is underway at all parks, along with aerification and seeding for areas that are in need. In fact, growth is starting to show from last month's seeding at Memorial.
- Stop signs are being installed at Alcyon Park next week around the entrance curve near the office. They will be on both sides of the road, along with 'incoming stop' signage before it.

Upcoming Programs/Events:

- Partnering with Crispin Basketball, the 2nd-4th grade in-house basketball program will start in January. There will also be a 1st and 2nd grade basketball program in addition, with Chuck Lang running it.
- We are looking at having indoor pitching sessions for softball and potentially baseball as well. Dates and locations are still being worked out.
- Tonight's meeting closed out with discussion about the playground equipment around town. Many of the pieces are over 20 years old, leading to wear and tear over time. Andy mentioned starting to price out these changes, along with the idea of possibly obtaining grants to help fund the project.
