Current programs and events:

-Registrations are still available for T-ball this Spring. The program is scheduled to start in the middle of April (likely the third week of the month). We will still be doing virtual practices Wednesday nights with videos to help with principles and fundamentals. Taping of the videos will start next week with all of them being available at the start of the program.

-Registrations are also available for the Spring Tennis program. The program will start April 12 and run until May 12. Next Wednesday (3/10), repairs will begin on the wall along the tennis courts. The resurfacing of the courts is going to bid, so that can hopefully begin soon.

-Healthy Kids Running will start on April 11. The five-week running program will take place Sunday evenings at Alcyon Lake Park.

-The Pitman Easter Egg Scramble will take place on March 27 starting at 9:00 AM. Groups will be maxed out at 25 kids. Times will be staggered to keep numbers manageable and to allow for Covid protocols/safety measures.
