Current Programs/Events:

- T-ball ends this Saturday (6/3). There were weekends lost because of rain, and those games had to be made up during the week. It was another great turnout this year.
- Spring Tennis ended two weeks ago, with its usual strong turnout.
- Speaking of tennis, the resurfacing of the courts is under way. It will include power washing and painting. Upcoming Programs/Events:

Our upcoming Summer programs:
