Current programs and events:

-Alcyon Lake Park has been getting ready for fall baseball and softball. In addition to some adult leagues playing, there will be a few town teams playing on the fields.

-The Heart of a Champion basketball camp finished its final days and is scheduled to return next year.

-Micro mini soccer starts 9/19 until a new format this season. There will be no Wednesday sessions. Instead, it will be just on Saturday mornings on the two fields at ALP. The teams are set, with the first 15-20 minutes reserved for drills. The rest of the time will be for playing.

-Middle school field hockey will not run this year. Other towns are not running either, so it does not seem feasible. There could be an in-house program run by Jen Mazzola later this fall.

-The annual Columbus Day golf outing, The George Heagele Tournament, has been cancelled this year.

Upcoming programs and events:

-Healthy Kids Running will start its third year on 9/27 and will run on Sunday evenings for five weeks. This year will have Covid protocols in place, including limited numbers and no gathering afterwards.

-A new Back to School Bootcamp starts on 9/14 and runs on Monday afternoons after school from 4:00-4:45 PM at ALP. It will be run by Andrea Whilden for kids 9-14 years old. The goal is to incorporate fun and effective movement exercises to help encourage active lifestyles for the youth of the town.

-We are looking to fill a full-time park assistant position at ALP.
