What's Going on Over At . . . ?

Township Hall gets a lot of questions regarding new projects, as economic development, growth, and job creation are thriving in Plymouth Township. Major developments recently completed or currently underway in the Township include:

- Henry Ford Hospital at the former K-Mart site opening 2022
- Webasto manufacturing components for the new Ford Bronco
- Amazon distribution center using former Spartan trucking facility
- Historic Phoenix Mill redeveloped for business and event space
- Panera's at Five and Beck
- Starbucks on Beck next to Buddy's Pizza
- Henry Ford Optimize, Chipotle and T-Mobile on Ann Arbor Road
- Apartments coming to former Courthouse Grill site
- National supermarket chain coming next to LA Fitness
- New home projects for families, young professionals and active seniors

The former DeHoCo Prison grounds along Five Mile Road also continues to see progress, with new businesses in the "Ridge 5" development area, and up to 300,000 square feet of new warehouse construction planned north of Adient at Halyard and Ridge.

Since the summer of 2020, Plymouth Township has seen more than \$91 million in new development and redevelopment. These current and future projects are improving our tax base, while promoting the 'brand' of Plymouth Community as a welcoming place to work, live and play.

Plymouth Township Christmas and New Year's Holiday Schedule

Yard Waste Collection and Christmas Tree Pick Up

Yard waste collection will continue through Friday, January 14, 2022 (the last day of pick up).

Christmas Tree Pick up will take place Monday, January 3, 2022 through Friday, January 14, 2022, on your normal collection day.

The Township accepts used batteries. Residents can dropoff their household batteries in the collection cylinder located on the second floor of Township Hall. This collection is for dry cell household batteries ONLY, like alkaline and button batteries. Lithium, lithium ion, and rechargeable batteries are NOT accepted. A Message About Snow and Snow Emergencies in Plymouth Township

Winter is HERE! And with the season here in Michigan we can expect more than our share of heavy snow days, closing schools, and making driving and walking a challenge.

The Township wants to remind residents and guests about the following snow-related items:

- » Plymouth Township does <u>not</u> plow streets; this is the responsibility of Wayne County Roads or your own Homeowner's Association by private contract.
- » The Township only salts sidewalks and pathways on township-owned property; Wayne County Roads or your Homeowner's Association salts streets.
- » Residents and businesses must remove snow and ice from their adjacent sidewalks within 24 hours of a snow or ice event or be subject to an ordinance violation.
- » Plymouth Township does not issue "Snow Emergencies," but when you hear of a Snow Emergency on TV or radio, please be considerate and move your vehicle off the street so County or contracted snow plows can do their job.

Recycling Options Expanding in Township

We are happy to announce that our partnership with "Simple Recycling" has returned. The only major change in this service is that you must contact them directly to schedule a pickup, as they are no longer collecting on your trash day. Simple Recycling is a convenient 'front door' collection program for used clothing, shoes, accessories, textiles, and small home goods. Township Issues Bids for Trash Hauling Services

The Township's waste hauling and recycling contract with GFL expires in September of 2022. In October of this year, the Township Board agreed to issue a Request for Bids (RFB) for trash hauling services for the next five years. The bids are due in late April of 2022. The Township Supervisor will then review the proposals and the Board of Trustees will interview finalists in a public meeting. The entire process will be fully transparent, and we'd appreciate your input. Hilltop Golf Course Posts Record Revenue

The 2021 season at the Township's Hilltop Golf Course was the best ever! Our new golf course managers, in cooperation with the Township, have continued to make improvements to the course, pathways, tee boxes, and

clubhouse for a more positive experience. When combined with the public's renewed interest in golf, the course is expected to generate roughly \$75,000 in profit for the Township in 2021. Next year, expect even more upgrades and improvements to the course, and new golf carts that are being leased by the Township. 
I-275 Work Continues, Causing Disruption

As mentioned in the last newsletter, the State of Michigan's I-275 reconstruction project will continue for the next three years. The bad news is that this will increase vehicular and truck traffic and drive times on our major roads, like Ann Arbor Road, Haggerty, and Sheldon as motorists seek alternative routes. There is also an MDOT Concrete Crushing facility at Ann Arbor Road and 275 that the Township will continue to monitor. The good news is that badly-needed regional improvements will be made to I-275, and our local entranceway at Ann Arbor Road will see dramatic improvements in landscaping, trees and new welcome signage in the years ahead.



Township Planting Trees in 2022

One of the best ways to help the environment is to plant a tree! Plymouth Township is once again looking to plant hundreds of trees in 2022 in public easements and other public spaces. Trees will need to be planted and maintained by residents and businesses that apply to the Township and successfully meet other Township requirements. 
