DISPOSAL GUIDE FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Unwanted portions of hazardous products used in the home are considered to be Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). These products should be treated in a careful manner to avoid accidents or pollution of our environment. The ideal method of disposal for Household Hazardous Waste is

to use it for its intended purpose. However, if you have hazardous products that you need to dispose of, the Charter Township of Plymouth offers a free hazardous waste collection day once each spring and Wayne County offers several collections throughout the year.
