 - 1) First Reading of Amendment 2 to Ordinance 1016 Medical Marijuana Moratorium

Attorney Cronin explained the reason for extending the moratorium an additional nine months. The Michigan Supreme Court granted a leave to appeal the Court of Appeals decision in a case involving the City of Wyoming, which has medical marijuana zoning ordinance, virtually identical to Plymouth Township's. Wyoming's ordinance had been struck down by the Court of Appeals.

Moved by Ms. Arnold, seconded by Mr. Kelly, to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 1016, Amendment 2, the Medical Marijuana Act Moratorium Ordinance. Ayes all on a roll call vote.

A copy of the Ordinance is on file in the Clerk's office for public perusal.

2) Approval of Application 2099 - PUD Option - Ravines of Plymouth

Mrs. Radtke reviewed the recommendation of the Planning Commission to approve the Planned Unit Development Option for the vacant land north of Plymouth Road, east of Edward Hines Drive, west of Haggerty Road.

Mr. Danny Veri of Livonia Builders addressed the Board and answered questions regarding the construction of upscale townhouse-like rental units on the property.

Moved by Ms. Arnold, seconded by Mr. Kelly, to approve Application 2099, Ravines of Plymouth, which would allow Parcel R-78-029-99-0004-000 to be developed under a Planned Unit Development (PUD) Option, subject to the following conditions as recommended by the Planning Commission:

- 1. The amount of brick on the exterior of the buildings must be increased.
- 2. Existing healthy vegetation must be retained on the site.

Ayes all.

3) Rezone Parcel R-78-042-99-0002-701 on N Territorial

Mrs. Radtke reviewed the Planning Commission recommendations.

Moved by Ms. Arnold, seconded by Ms. Conzelman, to approve Application 2098 for the rezoning of Parcel R-78-042-99-0002-701 from AG (Agricultural) to R-1-S (Single Family Residential), as described in the Amended Zoning Map. Ayes all.

ABATEMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH AND FZB //du try // c.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22 of Act 334 of the Public Acts of 1993, it is necessary for the "Township" and the "Company" to enter into a written agreement prior to approval and issuance of an Industrial Facility Exemption Certificate; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement must formally accompany any application made by the "Company" for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate to the State of Michigan, outlining the conditions and resources to be upheld during an abatement period.

WHEREAS, the Township desires to provide the abatement as evidenced in the application for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

The "Company" agrees to satisfy the following conditions and the "Company" understands and acknowledges that failure to satisfy any one of the conditions could result in the Township Board adopting a resolution recommending to the State Tax Commission revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate at the sole option of the "Township":

- 1. The "Company" agrees to submit a report regarding status of employment every two (2) years during the abatement period beginning with an initial report filed no later than the 10th day of January immediately following the second year after the issuance date of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" shall in no event neglect to submit the above report upon thirty (30) days written notice from the "Township". The report must include:
 - The number of new jobs promised in the application and the actual number of new jobs created to date; and
 - If the number of applicant's employees is not equal to or greater than the number given in the application, an explanation for any shortfall shall be included; and

c) The estimated project cost in the application and the actual final project cost to date (required in the initial report only).

The "Company" understands that if employment has not been retained or reached as stated in the application or the construction and/or expansion project has not been completed or expenditures made as described in the application, the "Township" has the right to recommend revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate by resolution presented to the State Tax Commission.

- 2. The "Company" or an agency or affiliate designated by the "Company", is encouraged to contribute some percentage of its abated taxes yearly to local charitable organizations or community service groups or to the "Township" with a designation that the contribution is to be used for a specific purpose.
- 3. If in any year during the abatement period the "Company" invokes the jurisdiction of the Michigan Tax Tribunal for the purpose of seeking a reduction of the assessed and/or taxable value of the real property to which the abatement applies as a result of a petition filed by the "Company" for such year, the "Company" shall immediately refund to each taxing authority the amount(s) abated during all years covered by this Certificate based on the higher assessment minus the amount(s) abated based on the reduced assessment. The "Company" shall also abandon and return to the "Township" this Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" agrees that this is a contractual right and may be enforced in a court of competent jurisdiction. No sanctions hereunder will accrue to the "Company" in the event it files an action in the Michigan Tax Tribunal with respect to the abated property in order to correct a clerical error of the Assessor such as an error in addition or subtraction.

If in any year during the abatement period the "Company" invokes the jurisdiction of the Michigan Tax Tribunal for the purpose of seeking a reduction of the assessed and/or taxable value of the personal property to which the abatement applies beyond that allowed by State Tax Commission Depreciation Table assigned to the property by the Township Assessor, the "Company" shall immediately refund to each taxing authority the amount(s) abated during all years covered by this Certificate based on the higher assessment minus the amount(s) abated based on the reduced assessment. The "Company" shall also abandon and return to the "Township" this Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" agrees that this is a contractual right and may be enforced in a court of competent jurisdiction. No sanctions hereunder will accrue to the "Company" in the event it files an action in the Michigan Tax Tribunal with respect to the abated property in order to correct a clerical error of the Assessor such as an error in addition or subtraction.

It will be a substantial default of this Agreement if the "Company" asserts to any court or administrative agency during the term of this Agreement that the true cash value of the property (real or personal) is other than or different than the amounts stated in the tax abatement application. The "Company" hereby stipulates and certifies that it has accurately valued the personal property and/or real property which is the subject of the abatement and the "Township" can rely on the figures represented in the application.

The "Company" agrees to reimburse the "Township" for any costs the "Township" incurs in responding to or contesting any appeal the "Company" asserts to any court or administrative agency during the term of this Agreement that the true cash value of the property (real or personal) is other than or different than the amount stated in the tax abatement application except as offset by applicable State Tax Commission Depreciation Table(s) and asset disposals. The costs subject to this section include attorney fees, appraisal costs, filing fees, expert witness fees, travel costs, copying expense, and any other cost or expense reasonably incurred by the "Township" in responding to or defending against such assertions.

- 4. The parties hereto further agree that if any of the above referenced conditions are not met within thirty (30) days after written notice by the "Township" of such failure, thereafter the "Township" may recommend revocation of this tax abatement. The "Township" shall not recommend such revocation until after a hearing is conducted wherein the "Company" shall be offered an opportunity to demonstrate why it has not breached any of the conditions set forth above or any other reasons why the tax abatement should not be revoked. The "Company" shall be given thirty (30) days written notice of such hearing which shall be conducted by the "Township" or its designee.
- 5. The determination of whether to recommend revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate shall be in the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees of the "Township."

In the alternative after such hearing, the Board of Trustees of the "Township" may require the "Company" to post a performance bond, funded by a percentage of the abated taxes, or may sue for money damages in a court of competent jurisdiction, in lieu of or in addition to recommending revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The performance bond shall be limited to the amount of abated taxes to ensure that all of the above conditions are met. The calculation of the amount of the bond shall be determined by the Board of Trustees of the "Township" and shall be binding upon the "Company" absent manifest error. The "Township" may make a claim against and enforce the terms of that performance bond.

By signature of representatives of both the "Company" and the "Township", it is understood that both the "Company's" investment in the project and the "Township's" investment through the granting of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate are to encourage the economic growth of all.

It is also acknowledged that certain economic conditions can, at times, prohibit the maintenance of the "Company's" targeted status. It is understood that if such conditions exist at the time of the designated "Company" reports, the governing body of the "Township" will carefully evaluate the "Company's" situation, and will inform the "Company" if any action is considered in order to give the "Company" an opportunity for correction.

Instruction for Completing Form 1012, Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption (IFT) Application

The completed original application form 1012 and all required attachments, plus two additional copies, MUST be filed with the clerk of the local unit of government where the facility is or will be located. Complete applications must be received by the State Tax Commission by October 31 to ensure processing and certification for the following tax year. Applications received after the October 31 deadline will be processed as expeditiously as possible.

Please note that attachments listed on the application in number 16a are to be retained by the local unit of government, and attachments listed in number 16b are to be included with the application when forwarding to the State Tax Commission (STC).

(Before commencement of a project the local unit of government must establish a district, or the applicant must request in writing a district be established, in order to qualify for an IFT abatement. Applications and attachments must be received by the local unit of government within six months of commencement of project.)

The following information is required on separate documents attached to form 1012 by the applicant and provided to the local unit of government (city, township or village) in triplicate. (Providing an accurate school district where the facility is located is vital.):

- Legal description of the real property on which the facility is or will be located. Also provide property identification number if available.
- 2. Personal Property Requirements: Complete list of new machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures which will be used in the facility. The list should include description, beginning date of installation or expected installation by month/day/year, and costs or expected costs (see sample). Detail listing of machinery and equipment must match amount shown on question 6b of the application. Personal property applications must have attached a certified statement/affidavit as proof of the beginning date of installation (see sample).
- 3. Real Property Requirements: Proof of date the construction started (groundbreaking). Applicant must include one of the following if the project has already begun; building permit, footings inspection report, or certified statement/affidavit from contractor indicating exact date of commencement.
- 4. Complete copy of lease agreement as executed, if

applicable, verifying lessee (applicant) has direct ad valorem real and/or personal property tax liability. The applicant must have real and/or personal property tax liability to qualify for an IFT abatement on leased property. If applying for a real property tax exemption on leased property, the lease must run the full length of time the abatement is granted by the local unit of government.

The following information is required of the local unit of government: [Please note that only items 2, 4, 5, 6, & 7 below are forwarded to the State Tax Commission with the application, along with items 2 & 3 from above. The original and one complete copy are required by the STC. The remaining items are to be retained at the local unit of government for future reference. (The local unit must verify that the school district listed on all IFT applications is correct.)

- A copy of the notice to the general public and the certified notice to the property owners concerning the establishment of the district.
- 2. Certified copy of the resolution establishing the Industrial Development District (IDD) or Plant Rehabilitation District (PRD), which includes a legal description of the district (see sample). If the district was not established prior to the commencement of construction, the local unit shall include a certified copy or date stamped copy of the written request to establish the district.
- Copy of the notice and the certified letters to the taxing authorities regarding the hearing to approve the application.
- 4. Certified copy of the resolution approving the application. The resolution must include the number of years the local unit is granting the abatement and the statement "the granting of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate shall not have the effect of substantially impeding the operation of (governmental unit), or impairing the financial soundness of a taxing unit which levies ad valorem property taxes in (governmental unit see sample).
- Letter of Agreement (signed by the local unit of government and the applicant per P.A. 334 of 1993 (see sample).

- Affidavit of Fees (signed by the local unit of government and the applicant), (Bulletin 3, January 16, 1998). This statement may be incorporated into the Letter of Agreement (see sample).
- Treasury Form 3222 (if applicable) Fiscal Statement for Tax Abatement Request.

The following information is required for rehabilitation applications in addition to the above requirements:

- A listing of existing machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures which will be replaced or renovated. This listing should include description, beginning date of installation or expected installation by month/day/year, and costs or expected costs.
- 2. A rehabilitation application must include a statement from the Assessor showing the taxable valuation of the plant rehabilitation district, separately stated for real property (EXCLUDING LAND) and personal property. Attach a statement from the assessor indicating the obsolescence of the property being rehabilitated.

The following information is required for speculative building applications in addition to the above requirements:

- 1.A certified copy of the resolution to establish a speculative building.
- A statement of non-occupancy from the owner and the assessor.

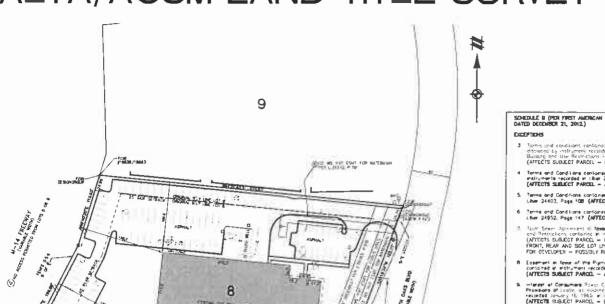

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22 of Act 334 of the Public Acts of 1993, it is necessary for the "Township" and the "Company" to enter into a written agreement prior to approval and issuance of an Industrial Facility Exemption Certificate; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement must formally accompany any application made by the "Company" for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate to the State of Michigan, outlining the conditions and resources to be upheld during an abatement period.

WHEREAS, the Township desires to provide the abatement as evidenced in the application for an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

The "Company" agrees to satisfy the following conditions and the "Company" understands and acknowledges that failure to satisfy any one of the conditions could result in the Township Board adopting a resolution recommending to the State Tax Commission revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate at the sole option of the "Township":

- 1. The "Company" agrees to submit a report regarding status of employment every two (2) years during the abatement period beginning with an initial report filed no later than the 10th day of January immediately following the second year after the issuance date of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" shall in no event neglect to submit the above report upon thirty (30) days written notice from the "Township". The report must include:
 - a) The number of new jobs promised in the application and the actual number of new jobs created to date; and
 - If the number of applicant's employees is not equal to or greater than the number given in the application, an explanation for any shortfall shall be included; and

c) The estimated project cost in the application and the actual final project cost to date (required in the initial report only).

The "Company" understands that if employment has not been retained or reached as stated in the application or the construction and/or expansion project has not been completed or expenditures made as described in the application, the "Township" has the right to recommend revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate by resolution presented to the State Tax Commission.

- 2. The "Company" or an agency or affiliate designated by the "Company", is encouraged to contribute some percentage of its abated taxes yearly to local charitable organizations or community service groups or to the "Township" with a designation that the contribution is to be used for a specific purpose.
- 3. If in any year during the abatement period the "Company" invokes the jurisdiction of the Michigan Tax Tribunal for the purpose of seeking a reduction of the assessed and/or taxable value of the real property to which the abatement applies as a result of a petition filed by the "Company" for such year, the "Company" shall immediately refund to each taxing authority the amount(s) abated during all years covered by this Certificate based on the higher assessment minus the amount(s) abated based on the reduced assessment. The "Company" shall also abandon and return to the "Township" this Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" agrees that this is a contractual right and may be enforced in a court of competent jurisdiction. No sanctions hereunder will accrue to the "Company" in the event it files an action in the Michigan Tax Tribunal with respect to the abated property in order to correct a clerical error of the Assessor such as an error in addition or subtraction.

If in any year during the abatement period the "Company" invokes the jurisdiction of the Michigan Tax Tribunal for the purpose of seeking a reduction of the assessed and/or taxable value of the personal property to which the abatement applies beyond that allowed by State Tax Commission Depreciation Table assigned to the property by the Township Assessor, the "Company" shall immediately refund to each taxing authority the amount(s) abated during all years covered by this Certificate based on the higher assessment minus the amount(s) abated based on the reduced assessment. The "Company" shall also abandon and return to the "Township" this Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The "Company" agrees that this is a contractual right and may be enforced in a court of competent jurisdiction. No sanctions hereunder will accrue to the "Company" in the event it files an action in the Michigan Tax Tribunal with respect to the abated property in order to correct a clerical error of the Assessor such as an error in addition or subtraction.

It will be a substantial default of this Agreement if the "Company" asserts to any court or administrative agency during the term of this Agreement that the true cash value of the property (real or personal) is other than or different than the amounts stated in the tax abatement application. The "Company" hereby stipulates and certifies that it has accurately valued the personal property and/or real property which is the subject of the abatement and the "Township" can rely on the figures represented in the application.

The "Company" agrees to reimburse the "Township" for any costs the "Township" incurs in responding to or contesting any appeal the "Company" asserts to any court or administrative agency during the term of this Agreement that the true cash value of the property (real or personal) is other than or different than the amount stated in the tax abatement application except as offset by applicable State Tax Commission Depreciation Table(s) and asset disposals. The costs subject to this section include attorney fees, appraisal costs, filing fees, expert witness fees, travel costs, copying expense, and any other cost or expense reasonably incurred by the "Township" in responding to or defending against such assertions.

- 4. The parties hereto further agree that if any of the above referenced conditions are not met within thirty (30) days after written notice by the "Township" of such failure, thereafter the "Township" may recommend revocation of this tax abatement. The "Township" shall not recommend such revocation until after a hearing is conducted wherein the "Company" shall be offered an opportunity to demonstrate why it has not breached any of the conditions set forth above or any other reasons why the tax abatement should not be revoked. The "Company" shall be given thirty (30) days written notice of such hearing which shall be conducted by the "Township" or its designee.
- 5. The determination of whether to recommend revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate shall be in the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees of the "Township."

In the alternative after such hearing, the Board of Trustees of the "Township" may require the "Company" to post a performance bond, funded by a percentage of the abated taxes, or may sue for money damages in a court of competent jurisdiction, in lieu of or in addition to recommending revocation of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate. The performance bond shall be limited to the amount of abated taxes to ensure that all of the above conditions are met. The calculation of the amount of the bond shall be determined by the Board of Trustees of the "Township" and shall be binding upon the "Company" absent manifest error. The "Township" may make a claim against and enforce the terms of that performance bond.

By signature of representatives of both the "Company" and the "Township", it is understood that both the "Company's" investment in the project and the "Township's" investment through the granting of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate are to encourage the economic growth of all.

It is also acknowledged that certain economic conditions can, at times, prohibit the maintenance of the "Company's" targeted status. It is understood that if such conditions exist at the time of the designated "Company" reports, the governing body of the "Township" will carefully evaluate the "Company's" situation, and will inform the "Company" if any action is considered in order to give the "Company" an opportunity for correction.

The completed original application form 1012 and all required attachments, plus two additional copies, MUST be filed with the clerk of the local unit of government where the facility is or will be located. Complete applications must be received by the State Tax Commission by October 31 to ensure processing and certification for the following tax year. Applications received after the October 31 deadline will be processed as expeditiously as possible.

Please note that attachments listed on the application in number 16a are to be retained by the local unit of government, and attachments listed in number 16b are to be included with the application when forwarding to the State Tax Commission (STC).

(Before commencement of a project the local unit of government must establish a district, or the applicant must request in writing a district be established, in order to qualify for an IFT abatement. Applications and attachments must be received by the local unit of government within six months of commencement of project.)

The following information is required on separate documents attached to form 1012 by the applicant and provided to the local unit of government (city, township or village) in triplicate. (Providing an accurate school district where the facility is located is vital.):

- Legal description of the real property on which the facility is or will be located. Also provide property identification number if available.
- 2. Personal Property Requirements: Complete list of new machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures which will be used in the facility. The list should include description, beginning date of installation or expected installation by month/day/year, and costs or expected costs (see sample). Detail listing of machinery and equipment must match amount shown on question 6b of the application. Personal property applications must have attached a certified statement/affidavit as proof of the beginning date of installation (see sample).
- 3. Real Property Requirements: Proof of date the construction started (groundbreaking). Applicant must include one of the following if the project has already begun; building permit, footings inspection report, or certified statement/affidavit from contractor indicating exact date of commencement.
- 4. Complete copy of lease agreement as executed, if

applicable, verifying lessee (applicant) has direct ad valorem real and/or personal property tax liability. The applicant must have real and/or personal property tax liability to qualify for an IFT abatement on leased property. If applying for a real property tax exemption on leased property, the lease must run the full length of time the abatement is granted by the local unit of government.

The following information is required of the local unit of government: [Please note that only items 2, 4, 5, 6, & 7 below are forwarded to the State Tax Commission with the application, along with items 2 & 3 from above. The original and one complete copy are required by the STC. The remaining items are to be retained at the local unit of government for future reference. (The local unit must verify that the school district listed on all IFT applications is correct.)

- A copy of the notice to the general public and the certified notice to the property owners concerning the establishment of the district.
- 2. Certified copy of the resolution establishing the Industrial Development District (IDD) or Plant Rehabilitation District (PRD), which includes a legal description of the district (see sample). If the district was not established prior to the commencement of construction, the local unit shall include a certified copy or date stamped copy of the written request to establish the district.
- Copy of the notice and the certified letters to the taxing authorities regarding the hearing to approve the application.
- 4. Certified copy of the resolution approving the application. The resolution must include the number of years the local unit is granting the abatement and the statement "the granting of the Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate shall not have the effect of substantially impeding the operation of (governmental unit), or impairing the financial soundness of a taxing unit which levies ad valorem property taxes in (governmental unit see sample).
- Letter of Agreement (signed by the local unit of government and the applicant per P.A. 334 of 1993 (see sample).

- 6. Affidavit of Fees (signed by the local unit of government and the applicant), (Bulletin 3, January 16, 1998). This statement may be incorporated into the Letter of Agreement (see sample).
- 7. Treasury Form 3222 (if applicable) Fiscal Statement for Tax Abatement Request.

The following information is required for rehabilitation applications in addition to the above requirements:

- A listing of existing machinery, equipment, furniture and fixtures which will be replaced or renovated. This listing should include description, beginning date of installation or expected installation by month/day/year, and costs or expected costs.
- 2. A rehabilitation application must include a statement from the Assessor showing the taxable valuation of the plant rehabilitation district, separately stated for real property (EXCLUDING LAND) and personal property. Attach a statement from the assessor indicating the obsolescence of the property being rehabilitated.

The following information is required for speculative building applications in addition to the above requirements:

- A certified copy of the resolution to establish a speculative building.

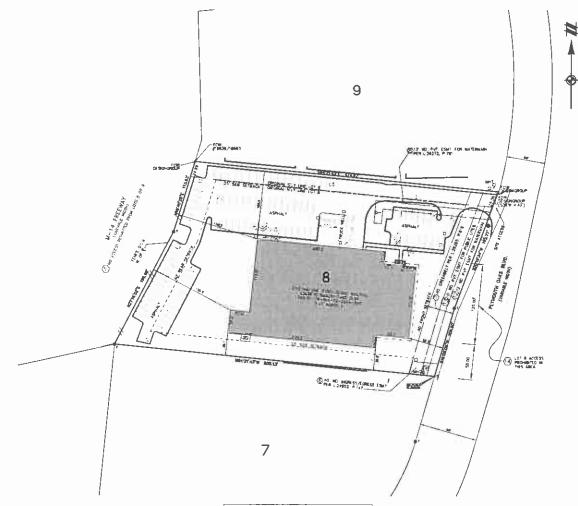

Honorable Board Members,

The board of the Woodlore North Homeowners Association expresses its opposition to the opening of a new entrance to Hilltop golf course at Ann Arbor Trail. Generally, we are opposed to this new entrance because we believe it will result in increased, and unwanted, motor vehicle traffic through our quiet neighborhood.

We believe this increased vehicle traffic will no-doubt negatively impact the safety of pedestrians in our neighborhood, especially children, given that our neighborhood streets lack adequate sidewalk infrastructure.

We are especially opposed to a new entrance that would leave open the dirt section of Powell Rd that connects with Beck Rd. Leaving this section of Powell Rd open would allow southbound traffic from Beck Rd to bypass the traffic light on Ann Arbor Trail and use our neighborhood streets as a shortcut to Ann Arbor Rd.

Almost as bad is a situation where, regardless of what is done to Powell Rd where it connects with Beck Rd, an entrance to Hilltop Golf Course directly lines up with the northern entrance to Woodlore North. We believe this layout would exacerbate any cut-thru problems described above and encourage traffic from Ann Arbor Rd to access the golf course by using our streets and thereby avoid traffic signals at Ann Arbor Rd/Beck and Ann Arbor Trail/Beck.

Some of our residents want to begin a petition drive to defeat the whole bond proposal. We believe there are a number of important improvements in the bond proposal that will be beneficial to the township. This is why we reach out to you so we may work together in the decision process and reach a conclusion that is satisfactory to all. Otherwise, we will have to mobilize in an effort to defeat the entire bond to preserve our peaceful streets.

These vehicles will provide the community with reliable, safe patrol vehicles when responding in the community to the various calls for service the police department receives daily. Patrol vehicles are utilized as mobile offices equipped with video cameras, on board computers and represent the community they serve and are at times needed to transport citizens from scenes.

Explain new or improved service that will result from new item: The newly designed Interceptor will replace 2 patrol units with 120,000 plus and mounting repair costs. The police department purchased the 2013 Interceptors and has been very pleased with their performance and meeting the needs of patrol officers.

Since increasing the mileage and keeping the vehicles in patrol longer, we have noticed repair costs rising due to transmission rebuilds, air conditioning compressors etc. We have also noticed that purchase prices of old patrol lehicles have declined from an average of \$3,500 to approximately \$2000. With the current mileage of 120,000 plus miles and the time it will take to have cars delivered and built for road patrol, these cars may top 140,000 miles. Again reducing the resale value even further.

Why is this new item needed? Why does the Township need to provide this service?

Patrol officers spend a large portion of their time in patrol vehicles and expect the vehicles to respond to the demands put on them under the various driving conditions. By replacing patrol vehicles, we will ensure that reliable vehicles will be patrolling the streets ensuring safety to the officers and community. Patrol vehicles are at times used to transport citizens from scenes and we must ensure that we are providing reliable vehicles as well as representing Plymouth Township. With Michigan's harsh seasons, patrol vehicles are exposed to sever weather and road conditions. Suspension and handling capabilities are a major concern when keeping vehicles for patrol duties. If these two areas fail during an emergency response the officer as well as the community can be placed in jeopardy exposing them to injury and liability. The addition of all wheel patrol vehicles will allow us to better respond to incidents during our harsh winters with large snow falls.

How will any current services be affected or changed if approved? What will happen if this item is Not approved?

If patrol vehicles are not purchased under the state/county bids special pricing offers will not be available to us. In years past with our regular rotation vehicles were purchased and put in to service when repair costs or damage became too expensive. With the change in the body style and appearance of the police interceptor additional items will need to be purchased. The traditional Crown Victoria is no longer being produced and is unavailable to us, we will slowly convert to the interceptor spreading the cost of conversion kits out over next few years.

If vehicles are purchased we expect our patrol fleet to provide our officers and the citizens of this community with safe reliable vehicles that reflect on a Township that cares about its employees and citizens as well as the professional image each and every officer strives to maintain.

Also with the change in body style, additional costs are to be expected for equipment conversion of approximately \$7000.00 per unit.

IIIIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT for the sale of Fireworks made and concluded this 12th day of February, A.D., 2013, by and between Zambelli Fireworks Manufacturing Co., the contractor, of New Castle, Pennsylvania, (hereinafter referred to as "Zambelli"),

Charter Township of Plymouth - Plymouth, Michigan (hereinafter refer

(hereinafter referred to as "Client")

WITNESSETH. For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, each to the other in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned. Zambelli and Client do mutually and severally agree to perform their several and respective covenants and to comply with all terms, conditions, and payments of this contract:

ZAMBELLI agrees:

To sell, furnish and deliver to Client, Fireworks to be exhibited on the following dates set forth and agreed upon at the time of signing this contract and Client agrees to
pay Zambelli for the Fireworks as follows

Display Date:

July 3, 2013

Postponement Date: July 5, 2013 (July 4th rain date is not available)

Contract Amount: \$35,000.00; 50% due upon signing the Contract and balance due at Noon three days prior to the scheduled display date, all payments shall be made by Draft, Certified Check or Wire Transfer. Checks shall be made payable to Zambelli Fireworks Manufacturing Co., unless otherwise authorized in writing, NO CASH shall be paid to any agent or employee of Zambelli without written authority.

2. ZAMBELLI further agrees to furnish, sufficient trained personnel to present a display

CLIENT further agrees:

- 3. To procure and furnish a suitable place to display the said fireworks; to furnish the necessary police and fire protection; to secure all, Police, Local, and State Permits, and to arrange for any security bonds or insurance as required by law in their community when necessary;
- Prior to, during, and immediately following the display. Client shall be solely responsible to keep all person (except employees of Zambelli) out of the designated danger areas and behind safety zone lines and limits;
- Following the display Client & Zambelli shall be responsible for reasonable cleanup and policing of the display area: Zambelli will be responsible for the removal of all unexploded fireworks, removal of frames, sets and lumber, and refilling of holes

The PARTIES mutually agree:

- It is agreed and understood by the parties hereto that in the event Fireworks have been taken out and set up before inclement weather and with adequate weather prevailing, such exhibition of fireworks will be carried out in the best possible manner without any deductions from the before named compensations. Should inclement weather prevent firing of said display on the aforementioned Display Date, then it will be understood that program is postponed and will be fired on the aforementioned Postponement Date, and there will be a charge to cover the cost of Postponement of 15%. If there is no alternate date and the program is not fired on the aforementioned Display Date, then it will be understood the program is cancelled and there will be a charge to cover the costs of cancellation of 50%.
- Zambelli reserves the exclusive right to make minor modifications and substitutions provided that such changes are reasonable and necessary and do not materially
 adversely affect price, time of delivery, functional character or display performance
- 8. If the location of the firing site, spectator's location, parking areas or structures is deemed unsuitable or unsafe, in the discretion of Zambelli or its agents or personnel, Zambelli may refuse to fire the display until conditions are corrected. If such conditions are not corrected, Zambelli may cancel the display without further liability to the Client for such cancellation.
- 9. This contract shall be deemed made in the State of Michigan and shall be constructed in accordance with the laws of Michigan. The parties agree and consent to the jurisdiction of Michigan to determine conflicts regarding the language and payments to be made under this Contract.
- If client becomes bankrupt or insolvent, or if a petition in bankruptcy is filed by or against the Client or if a receiver is appointed for the Client, Zambelli may refuse to make further delivery and may terminate this contract without prejudice to the rights of Zambelli. If the Client's financial conditions become unsatisfactory to Zambelli, Zambelli may require the balance of the purchase price to be deposited in escrow or the Client to provide sufficient proof of its ability to pay the balance of the contract price. Client is not entitled to recover incidental or consequential damages in connection with any breach of this Contract.
- 11. If Chent fails to pay the montes due under this contract, Zambelli is entitled to recover the balance due plus interest at 1 ½ % per month on amounts past due 60 days or more. Further, on balance outstanding of 120 days or more, Zambelli is entitled to recover the balance due, plus accrued interest, plus attorneys fees of 10% of the amount past due, plus court costs.
- 12 This contract shall not be constructed to create a partnership between the parties or persons mentioned herein.
- In the event of fire, accident, strikes, delay, flood, act of God or other causes beyond the control of Zambelli, which prevent delivery of said materials, the parties hereto release each other from any and all performance of the covenants herein contained and from damages resulting from the breach thereof.
- Zambelli shall provide \$10,000,000 of hability insurance with no more than \$2,000,000 in loss run for the current policy period, such insurance being in the form and by an insurer acceptable to the Township, which acceptance shall not be unreasonably withheld, naming the Township, it's employees, elected officials and any other parties as additional named insureds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION FOR RIDGEWOOD HILLS SUBDIVISIONS S.A.D. PAVING PROGRAM

The proposed improvements shall consist of milling, and/or pulverization, and/or removal of the existing bituminous road with the placement of a new bituminous pavement course. In addition, select areas of concrete curb and gutter will be removed and replaced as necessary. It is understood that this is primarily a road improvement project and therefore any drainage problems existing prior to the project will not be corrected except where said modification is necessary to protect the life of the road pavement. Existing water problems, such as standing water, etc., outside of the roadway will not be resolved by this program.
