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EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION EXHIBIT B PROJECT DESCRIPTION EXHIBIT C SIGNAGE SPECIFICATIONS THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is between the County of Wayne, Michigan, a public body corporate and Home Rule Charter County, acting through its Department of Public Services, Parks Division (hereinafter the "County") and the Charter Township of Plymouth, a Michigan municipal corporation (hereinafter "TOWNSHIP").

## 1. PURPOSE

1.01 The County and Plymouth Township have an interest in entering into cooperative parks and recreation projects that are mutually beneficial to the residents of Wayne County.

## 2. SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

2.01 The County will cooperatively fund the construction of improvements (the "Project") at Plymouth Township Park as designated in Exhibit A and B, located in the TOWNSHIP of PLYMOUTH (individually, "Site" or collectively, "Sites"), for the citizens of Wayne County, at the locations described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof. The County will finance any improvements agreed upon by the Chief Executive Officer for the County or his/her designee and the Supervisor of Plymouth Township or his/her designee, in creation of the Project under the limitations indicated in Sections 4 and 5.

## 3. TERM OF CONTRACT

3.01 The effective date of this Agreement is upon approval of a resolution by the Plymouth Township Board of Trustees and the Wayne County Commission and upon obtaining signatures from the Supervisor of Plymouth Township and the Wayne County Chief Executive Officer, whichever occurs last.

- 3.02 The Agreement shall remain in full force and effect during the Project, unless terminated before such time under the terms and conditions indicated in this Agreement.
- 3.03 If Plymouth Township fails to complete the Project within two years of the effective date, the parties agree that the County shall be under no further obligation to provide any remaining funds committed hereunder.

## 4. COUNTY'S COVENANTS

4.01 The County will fund construction of the recreational Project described in Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof. The funding provided by the County for the recreational Project shall not exceed Sixty-One Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$61,158,000.00).

## 5. TOWNSHIP'S COVENANTS

- 5.01 Prior to construction of any portion of the Project, Plymouth Township shall provide the County with documents evidencing title to each Site, including, but not limited to, deeds, assignments, leases, land contracts, and mortgage instruments. The documents must specify all covenants, restrictions, easements, or other encumbrances on each Site.
- 5.02 TOWNSHIP warrants that it is the legal owner with good, valid, and clear title to each Site described in Exhibit A.

TOWNSHIP shall, to the extent allowed by applicable law and without waiver of governmental immunity, hold harmless and defend the County against any claims, demands, penalties, fines, liabilities, settlements, damages, costs or expenses, including but not limited to, court costs and litigation expenses, known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, arising out of or in any way related to an action by a third party to quiet title in any Site described in Exhibit A.

- 5.03 Plymouth Township shall keep accurate records and account of the Project costs that shall be accessible for inspection and audit by a representative of the County, upon reasonable prior notice to the Plymouth Township.
- 5.04 Plymouth Township shall submit to the County no more frequently than once every 30 days, a certified application for reimbursement of acceptable Project costs together with all contractor and subcontractor certified invoices and any required supporting documentation for reimbursement, which shall be made upon receipt and approval of the application for reimbursement. The County is under no obligation to reimburse Plymouth Township for any unapproved costs or costs outside the scope of this Agreement.
- 5.05 TOWNSHIP shall be responsible for financing the Project beyond the financial commitment the County has made as indicated in Section 4.01.
- 5.06 TOWNSHIP shall operate and maintain the Plymouth Township Park Project as improved for public recreation, and that it shall allow the park to be open to the public on equal and reasonable terms and that no individual shall be denied ingress or egress thereto or the use thereof on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, national origin, residence, age or handicap.
- 5.07 TOWNSHIP agrees that in consideration of the financial commitment that the County is providing for the Project, Plymouth Township shall operate each Site as a recreational facility for no less than 10 years after the Project is completed.
- 5.08 Plymouth Township will develop signage at its own expense, which recognizes the County as a donor at each Site. The signage shall comply with the specifications described in Exhibit C attached hereto and made a part hereof, provided the signage complies with all applicable Plymouth Township ordinances and regulations. The County shall have the right to

approve the signage. Such approval will not be unreasonably withheld or delayed. Plymouth Township shall install the signage prior to the Project's completion.

5.09 TOWNSHIP agrees to provide the County with an opportunity to participate in planning any press conference, ribbon cutting ceremony, opening ceremony, or other public/media announcement related to the Project ("media event"). Plymouth Township further agrees to provide the County with no less than thirty (30) days' prior written notice of a proposed media event.

5.10 Breach of any of the provisions contained in this Article may be regarded as a material breach of this Agreement.

## 6. TERMINATION

6.01 This Agreement can be terminated by either party with or without cause upon 30 days' written notice, prior to commencing construction. If terminated prior to commencing construction of the Project, each party is solely responsible for its own costs, fees, and obligations incurred prior to the termination.

6.02 After the Project's construction is commenced, the County may terminate this Agreement with or without cause and shall be responsible for expenses previously approved by the County and incurred by Plymouth Township, not to exceed the amount stated in Section 4.01.

6.03 TOWNSHIP may terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, after construction is commenced and shall return to the County any funding provided by the same under this Agreement.

## 7. DATA TO BE FURNISHED

- 7.01 TOWNSHIP must maintain copies of all information, books, data, reports, records, etc., related to the Project. Such information and records shall be maintained for a period of three (3) years from the date Plymouth Township receives its final reimbursement payment under this Agreement.
- 7.02 Upon the request of the County or its authorized representative, including its Legislative Auditor General, Plymouth Township must furnish, without charge, copies of all information, books, records, data, reports, etc., of Plymouth Township, or any contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents rendering or furnishing services under this Agreement, whether direct or indirect, that will permit adequate evaluation or audit of the services provided by Plymouth Township or any of its contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents. Plymouth Township must include a similar covenant allowing for County audit in any agreement it has with a contractor, subcontractor, consultant or agent related to this Agreement. The County may delay reimbursement payments to Plymouth Township pending the results of any such audit without penalty or interest.
- 7.03 The County may schedule conferences at mutually convenient times with Plymouth Township administrative personnel to gather the information. If, as a result of any audit conducted by or for the County relating to Plymouth Township's performance under this Agreement, a discrepancy should arise as to the amount of compensation due Plymouth Township, Plymouth Township shall pay to the County on demand the amount of compensation in question, provided, however, that the Plymouth Township shall have the right to first review the audit documents and provided further that the parties shall meet in an attempt to informally negotiate a resolution to the alleged discrepancy before the County takes any further action. If

Plymouth Township fails or refuses to make payment, in addition to other legal remedies available to the County, the County may retain said amount from any funds allocated to Plymouth Township but not yet disbursed under this Agreement or may offset such a deficiency against the compensation to be paid Plymouth Township in any concurrent, successive or future agreements between the parties.

7.04 TOWNSHIP further acknowledges the right of the Wayne County Commission as a third-party beneficiary of this Agreement to sue for specific performance to enforce the audit rights provided herein for the Legislative Auditor General.

# 8. ADMINISTRATION

- **8.01** TOWNSHIP must inform the County as soon as the following types of conditions become known:
- 1. Probable delays or adverse conditions which do or may materially prevent meeting the objectives of this Agreement, including changes, transfer, or assignment of any real property interest related to any Site;
- Favorable developments or events that enable meeting time schedules or goals sooner than anticipated; or
- 3. Any changes or modifications in appropriations and funding for the Project.

# 9. <u>RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES</u>

9.01 The parties are independent entities. No liability or benefits, such as Workers' Compensation, pension rights, or insurance rights, arising out of, or related to a contract for hire or employer/employee relationship, accrues to either party or either party's agents, contractors, subcontractors, or employees as a result of this Agreement. No relationship, other than that of independent contractor will be implied between the parties, or either party's agents, employees, contractors, or subcontractors.

# 10. <u>INSURANCE</u>

10.01 All insurance secured by Plymouth Township or any contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents performing work related to this Agreement must be effected under valid and enforceable policies, issued by recognized, responsible insurers, licensed to do business in the State of Michigan and which are well-rated by national rating organizations.

10.02 TOWNSHIP, at its expense, or any contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents retained by Plymouth Township, at their own expense, shall maintain during the construction of the Project, Commercial General Liability Insurance with minimum limits for bodily injury of \$3 Million Dollars per occurrence and \$3 Million Dollars aggregate and with minimum limits for property damage of \$2 Million Dollars per occurrence and \$2 Million Dollars aggregate.

10.03 TOWNSHIP, at its expense, or any contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents retained by Plymouth Township, at their own expense, shall maintain during the construction of the Project, Workers Compensation coverage that meets Michigan statutory requirements and employer's liability insurance with at least \$500,000 limits.

10.04 TOWNSHIP, at its expense, or any contractors, subcontractors, consultants or agents retained by Plymouth Township, at their own expense, shall maintain during the construction of the Project, Automobile Liability Insurance, including coverage on hired and owned vehicles, with minimum limits for bodily injury and property damage of \$3,000,000 each accident.

10.05 If, during the term of this Agreement, changed conditions or other pertinent factors, should in the reasonable judgment of the County render inadequate the insurance limits, Plymouth Township will furnish on demand such additional coverage as may reasonably be required and available under the circumstances.

10.06 Insurance policies must name Plymouth Township as insured, name the County as an additional insured and loss payee, and must not be canceled, terminated or materially changed without at least thirty (30) days prior written notice from Plymouth Township to the County. Prior to execution of this Agreement by the parties, certificates evidencing such insurance must be submitted by Plymouth Township to the County's Risk Management Division located at 500 Griswold, 20th Floor, Detroit, Michigan 48226, and at least fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration dates of expiring policies.

10.07 Failure to comply with provisions contained in this Article may be deemed as a material breach of this Agreement.

## 11. HOLD HARMLESS

11.01 TOWNSHIP agrees to remain responsible for its own negligence, or tortious acts, errors, or omissions, and the acts, errors, or omissions of any of its employees, contractors, subcontractors, consultants, or agents. It is agreed that the County is merely acting as a funding

source for the Project and that any negligence, or tortious acts, errors, or omissions on the part of the County shall only arise out of providing these funds or processing reimbursement requests made by Plymouth Township as submitted pursuant to Section 5.04.

11.02 This hold harmless provision must not be construed as a waiver of any governmental immunity by the County or the Plymouth Township or their respective agencies, or employees, as provided by statute or modified by court decisions.

### 12. LIABILITY

12.01 The County does not assume and is not responsible for, payment of any debt service, lien, or encumbrance, including, but not limited to, mortgage, promissory note, land contract, or other obligation, incurred prior to the signing or during the term of this Agreement.

12.02 This Agreement is not intended to create beneficial rights in any third party other than the Wayne County Commission. This Agreement is entered into for the sole benefit of the parties to this Agreement.

### 13. ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

13.01 TOWNSHIP warrants to the County that Plymouth Township will not use Hazardous Materials (as defined in Section 13.06) at any Site in violation of any governmental regulation pertaining to the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of Hazardous Materials.

13.02 TOWNSHIP warrants that it is not in violation of governmental regulations pertaining to the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of Hazardous Materials at any Site, and, to the best of Plymouth

Township's knowledge, there have been no actions commenced or threatened by any party for noncompliance which affects a Site.

13.03 Plymouth Township will keep each Site free of Hazardous Materials except to the extent that the Hazardous Materials are stored or used in compliance with applicable local, state and federal regulations. Plymouth Township must not cause or permit any Site to be used to generate, manufacture, refine, transport, treat, store, handle, dispose of, transfer, produce, or process Hazardous Materials, except in compliance with governmental regulations. Plymouth Township shall not cause or permit, as a result of any intentional or unintentional act or omission on the part of Plymouth Township, any tenant, subtenant or occupant, the release, spill, leak or emission of Hazardous Materials at any Site or onto any other contiguous property.

13.04 Prior to commencing the Project, Plymouth Township must conduct and complete or cause to be conducted and completed an investigation, including a comprehensive environmental audit, studies, sampling, and testing, as the County deems necessary. A copy of any environmental audit, study, sampling or testing shall be provided to the County within ten (10) working days of Plymouth Township's receipt of such audit, study, sampling or testing. If the audit reveals the existence of any Hazardous Material at any Site, Plymouth Township shall immediately disclose the findings to the County. If the County decides to proceed with the Project, Plymouth Township shall do or cause to be done all remedial, removal and other actions necessary to clean up and remove all Hazardous Materials on, under, from or affecting the Site as required by all applicable governmental regulations, to the reasonable satisfaction of the County, and according to all federal, state and local governmental authorities. Any audit conducted by

the County is solely for the benefit, protection, and interest of the County. Plymouth Township or any third party cannot rely upon the audit conducted by the County for any purpose.

13.05 It is agreed that the County is merely acting as a funding source for the Project and that the County shall only be responsible for providing these funds and processing reimbursement requests made by Plymouth Township as submitted pursuant to Section 5.04. Therefore, the County shall not be responsible for any claims, demands, penalties, fines, liabilities, settlements, damages, costs or expenses, including attorney and consultant fees, investigation and laboratory fees, court costs and litigation expenses, known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, arising out of or in any way related to:

- The presence, disposal, release or threatened release of any Hazardous Materials
  on, over, under, from or affecting the Site or the soil, water, vegetation, buildings,
  personal property, persons or animals;
- Any personal injury (including wrongful death) or property damage (real or personal) arising out of or related to Hazardous Materials at a Site;
- 3. Any lawsuit brought or threatened, settlement reached or government order relating to the Hazardous Materials with respect to a Site:
- 4. Any violation of laws, orders, regulations, requirements or demands of government authorities, or any policies or requirements of any mortgage, which are based on or related to the Hazardous Materials used at a Site;
- 5. This section applies to the presence, disposal, release, leakage, or threatened release of any Hazardous Materials prior to the effective date of this Agreement.

# 13.06 Hazardous Material means any material or substance:

- Which is or becomes defined as a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (42 U.S.C. 9601 et. seq.) and any amendments thereto and regulations pursuant thereto;
- 2. Containing gasoline, oil, diesel, fuel, or other petroleum products;
- 3. Which is or becomes defined as hazardous waste pursuant to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (42 U.S.C. 6901 et. seq.) and any amendments thereto and regulations pursuant thereto;
- 4. Containing polychlorinated biphenyl;
- 5. Containing asbestos;
- 6. Which is radioactive;
- 7. The presence of which requires investigation or remediation under any governmental regulation; or
- 8. Which is or becomes defined as a hazardous waste, hazardous substance, pollutant, contaminant, or biologically hazardous material under any governmental regulation.

# 14. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

- 14.01 Each party must comply with and must require its employees to comply with all applicable laws and regulations.
- 14.02 TOWNSHIP must construct and develop the Project or cause the Project to be constructed and developed according to applicable local, state and federal laws.

# 15. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>

No amendment to this Agreement is effective unless it references this Agreement, is written, is signed and acknowledged by duly authorized representatives of both parties and approved by resolutions adopted by the Plymouth Township Board of Trustees and the Wayne County Commission.

# 16. **NONDISCRIMINATION PRACTICES**

16.01 TOWNSHIP shall require that all contractors, subcontractors, consultants and agents retained to perform work related to this Agreement comply with:

- A. Titles VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act (42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d et. seq.) and the United States Department of Justice Regulations (28 C.F.R. Part 42) issued pursuant to these Titles.
- B. The Age Discrimination Act of 1985 (42 U.S.C. §6101-07).
- C. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. §794).
- D. The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. §12101 et. seq.) and its associated regulations.
- E. The Michigan Civil Rights Act (P.A. 1976 No. 453) and the Persons With Disabilities Civil Rights Act (P.A. 1976 No. 220).
- F. The anti-discrimination provisions as required by Section 120-192 of the Wayne County Code of Ordinances.
- 16.02 All contractors, subcontractors, consultants and agents retained by Plymouth Township to perform work related to this Agreement shall not:

- A. Refuse to recruit, hire, employ, promote or to bar or discharge from employment an individual, or discriminate against an individual in compensation, terms, conditions or privileges of employment because of race, color, creed, national origin, age, marital status, handicap, sex, religion, familial status, height or weight.
- B. Limit, segregate, or classify an employee or applicant for employment in a way which deprives or tends to deprive any individual of employment opportunities or otherwise adversely affects the employment status of an employee because of race, color, creed, national origin, age, marital status, handicap, sex, familial status, height or weight.
- C. Print or publish or cause to be printed or published a notice, application, or advertisement relating to employment indicating a preference, limitation, specification, or discrimination based upon race, color, creed, national origin, age, marital status, handicap, sex, religion, familial status, height or weight.
- D. Except as permitted by rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to Section 120-192 of the Wayne County Code of Ordinances, or applicable state or federal law, make or use a written or oral inquiry or form of application that elicits or attempts to solicit information concerning the race, color, creed, national origin, age, marital status, handicap, sex, religion, familial status, height or weight, of prospective employees. Plymouth Township also shall not make or keep a record of that

information or disclose such information.

E. Make or use a written or oral inquiry or form of application that expresses a preference, limitation or specification based on religion, race, color, creed, national origin, age, height, weight, marital status, handicap, or sex.

16.03 TOWNSHIP agrees that it will notify all of its contractors, subcontractors, consultants, or agents of their obligations relative to non-discrimination under this Agreement when soliciting the contractor, subcontractor, consultant, or agent. Plymouth Township will include the provisions of this Article in any contract, as well as provide the County with a copy of any agreement with a contractor, subcontractor, consultant, or agent completing work related to this Agreement.

16.04 All contractors, subcontractors, consultants and agents retained by Plymouth Township to perform work related to this Agreement shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment, training, education, or apprenticeship connected directly or indirectly with the performance of this Agreement, with respect to hire, promotion, job assignment, tenure, terms, conditions or privileges of employment because of race, color, creed, national origin, age, marital status, handicap, sex, religion, familial status, height or weight. This Section does not apply if it is determined by the Plymouth Township that the requirements are bona fide occupational qualifications reasonably necessary to perform the duties required for employment. The burden of proof that the occupational qualifications are bona fide is upon Plymouth Township.

16.05 Breach of any of the covenants in this Article may be regarded as a material breach of this Agreement.

16.06 TOWNSHIP acknowledges the right of the COUNTY to sue to enforce the provisions in this Article.

16.07 If Plymouth Township or any of its contractors, subcontractors, consultants, or agents does not comply with the non-discrimination provisions of this Agreement, the County may impose reasonable sanctions, including but not limited to the cancellation, termination or suspension of this Agreement, in whole or in part.

16.08 In the event that Plymouth Township is or becomes subject to federal or state law which conflicts with the requirements of Section 120-192 of the Wayne County Code of Ordinances, the provisions of federal or state law shall apply and this Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced accordingly. In accordance with 1976 P.A. 453, Plymouth Township covenants not to discriminate against an employee or applicant for employment with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions, or privileges of employment because of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, weight, height, or marital status, and to require a similar covenant on the part of any contractor, subcontractor, consultant, or agent employed in the performance of this Agreement.

# 17. ETHICS IN CONTRACTING

17.01 TOWNSHIP and all of its contractors must comply with Article 12 of Chapter 120 of the Wayne County Code of Ordinances governing "Ethics in Public Contracting" or any similarly existing Plymouth Township ordinances.

# 18. NOTICES

18.01 All notices, consents, approvals, requests and other communications ("Notices") required or permitted under this Agreement must be given in writing and mailed by first-class mail and addressed as follows:

18.02 All notices are deemed given on the day of mailing. Either party to this Agreement may change its address for the receipt of notices at any time by giving notice to the other as provided. Any notice given by a party must be signed by an authorized representative of such party.

18.03 Termination notices, change of address notices, and other notices of a legal nature, are an exception and must be sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested.

### 19. WAIVER OF ANY BREACH

No failure by a party to insist upon the strict performance of any term of this Agreement or to exercise any term after a breach constitutes a waiver of any breach of term. No waiver of any breach affects or alters this Agreement, but every term of this Agreement remains effective with respect to any other then existing or subsequent breach.

# 20. <u>SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS</u>

If any provision of this Agreement or the application to any person or circumstance is, to any extent, judicially determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of the provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is invalid or unenforceable, is not affected and is enforceable.

# 21. MERGER CLAUSE

21.01 This Agreement, including the Exhibits contains the entire agreement between the parties and all prior negotiations and agreements are merged in this document. Neither party has made any representations except those expressly set forth in this Agreement. No rights or remedies are, or will be acquired by either party by implication or otherwise unless set forth herein.

21.02 This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original but all of which together will constitute one agreement.

# 22. JURISDICTION AND LAW

This Agreement, and all actions arising from it, must be governed by, subject to, and construed according to the laws of the State of Michigan. Each party consents to the personal jurisdiction of any competent court in Wayne County, Michigan, for any action arising out of this Agreement. Each party will not commence any action against the other because of any

matter arising out of this Agreement, in any courts other than those in the County of Wayne,

State of Michigan unless original jurisdiction is in the United States District Court for the

Eastern District of Michigan, Southern Division, the Court of Claims, the Michigan Supreme

Court or the Michigan Court of Appeals.

# 23. <u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>

23.01 It is mutually understood and agreed that neither of the parties hereto shall be held responsible for damages occasioned by delay or failure to perform where due to fire, strike, flood, acts of God, unavailability of labor, material, legal acts of public authorities, or delays caused by public carriers or third person (including contractors or subcontractors) which cannot reasonably be foreseen or provided against.

23.02 The parties agree that upon termination of this Agreement, the following sections shall survive termination and shall remain in full force and effect: 5.02; 11; 12; 13; 14 and 22.

23.03 The term "County" includes the Charter County of Wayne and all other associated, affiliated, or subsidiary departments or divisions now existing or to be created, their agents, and employees.

23.04 This Agreement must not be construed as a waiver of any governmental immunity the County, and the Plymouth Township and their respective agencies, or employees, has as provided by statute or modified by court decisions.

23.05 The headings of the articles in this Agreement are for convenience only and must not be used to construe or interpret the scope or intent of this Agreement or in any way affect this Agreement.

# 24. <u>AUTHORIZATION AND CAPABILITY</u>

24.01 This Agreement has been approved and executed by the Charter County of Wayne and the Township of Plymouth, as evidenced by the attached Resolutions adopted by Plymouth Township Board of Trustees and the Wayne County Commission. Copies of such resolutions shall be attached to this Agreement.

24.02 Each party warrants that the person signing this Agreement is authorized to sign on behalf of its principal and is empowered to bind its principal to this Agreement.

24.03 This Agreement is effective only upon review and approval by the Wayne County Commission, the Wayne County Chief Executive Officer, the Supervisor for the Township of Plymouth and Plymouth Township Board of Trustees, whichever occurs last.

# 25. SIGNATURE

25.01 The COUNTY and Plymouth Township, by their authorized officers and representatives have executed this Agreement as of the dates written below.

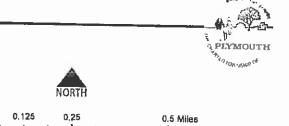

# Proposed Multi-Purpose Pavilion Plymouth Township Park

# **Project Description**

The Charter Township of Plymouth is proposing to construct a new multi-purpose pavilion at Plymouth Township Park, which is located to the northeast of Ann Arbor Trall and Beck Roads and is adjacent to the Golf Course. The new pavilion would be designed to provide universal access to park users of all ages and abilities, and would contain restrooms, a drinking fountain, concession area, picnic tables, and a storage area for field maintenance equipment. This facility would be used to support structured activities at the baseball diamonds, and to serve as a warming station for sledding in the winter. It would also be used to host the events of local community groups, and would provide opportunities for more casual recreation uses and social gatherings.

# Benefit to the Community

The Plymouth Township Park is the premier park within the Township. It contains approximately 63 acres, exclusive of the Golf Course, and is centrally located. The Park includes play structures, a sprayscape, baseball diamonds, a sledding hill, walking paths, and a barrier-free fishing dock. To support these activities, the Township has constructed one multi-purpose pavillon and two recreation shelters, which may be reserved for special events and family gatherings. The reservation program is open to both Township residents and non-residents and has become so successful that almost all weekends are usually booked by the end of February. Unsurprisingly, the Township has received numerous requests for an additional pavillon with restrooms and other amenities at Plymouth Township Park.

Although the existing pavillon is well-used, it is located in the southwest corner of the Park near the entrance. Because of the Park's large size, visitors engaged in activities at the baseball diamonds and sledding hill are required to walk over .25 miles downhill to the existing restrooms and picnic areas. This configuration poses difficulties for park users who are limited in terms of mobility due to age or disability. Consequently, the proposed pavilion is intended to correct the deficiency in recreation support facilities in the northeast portion of the Park, and to provide safe and convenient access to amenities for park users of all ages and abilities.

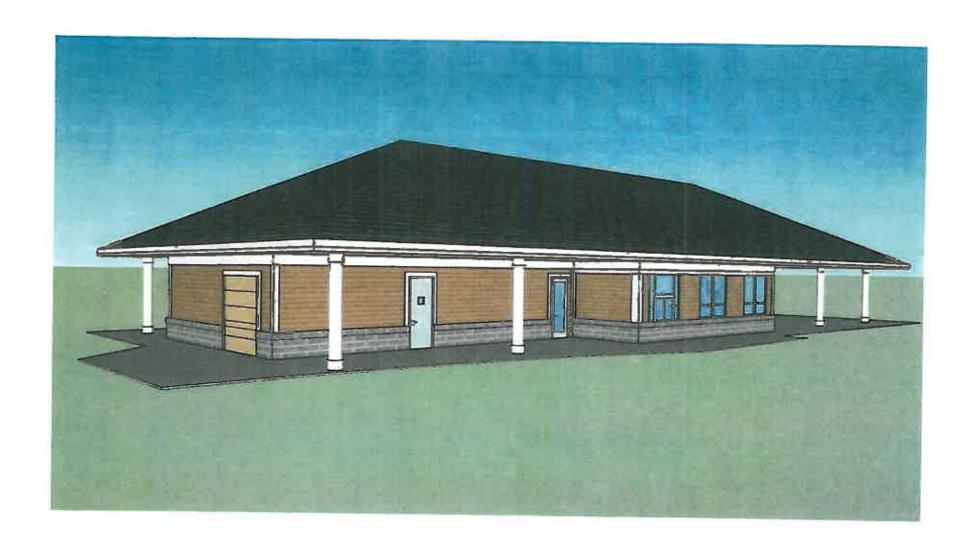
Proposed Project Summary - The project includes a new Park Pavilion at Township Park. The proposed park pavilion facility would be located on the south side of the ball diamonds overlooking the sled hill and the pond. The pavilion would be a four-season, multi-use facility to provide a wide range of amenities for users of the ball diamonds and sledding hill as well as rental opportunities and a gathering place for community groups.

Existing Conditions — The area is not currently served by a pavilion or by convenient restroom facilities, only portable toilets.

Proposed Improvements – The proposed Pavillon Facility would be a four-season, multi-use facility that would serve the needs of park users during both baseball and sledding season. The facility includes the following key features:

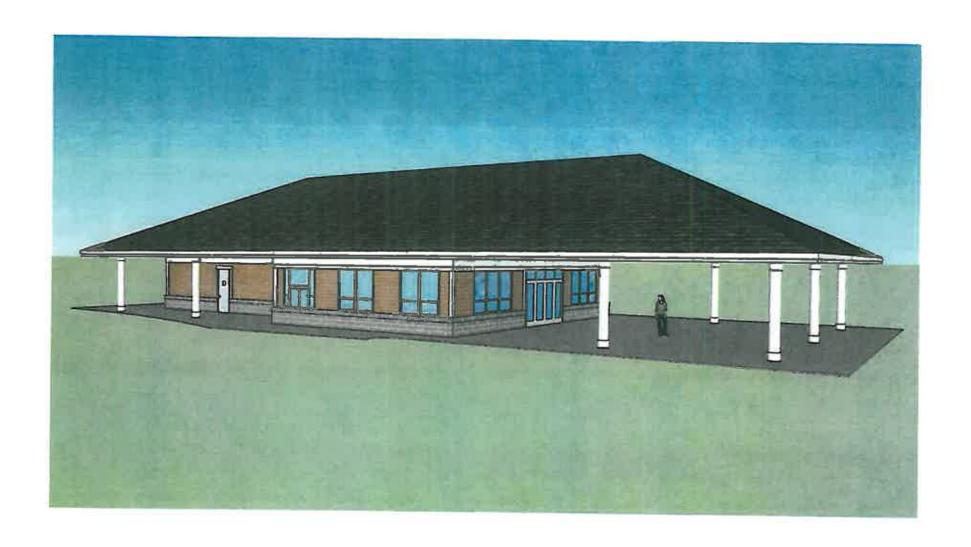
- 1,675 sq. ft. indoor seating/warming room.
- Snack Bar with concession window within the Indoor seating/warming room.
- 2,300 sq. ft. outdoor covered picnic area.
- ADA accessible restroom facilities.
- 500 sq. ft. equipment storage and mechanical room located in the rear of the facility.
- Windows around perimeter of indoor seating room to view adjacent sled hill and pond.
- Facility will be constructed of low maintenance durable materials.

Estimated Costs - The cost of the project is estimated to be \$600,000 as described above.



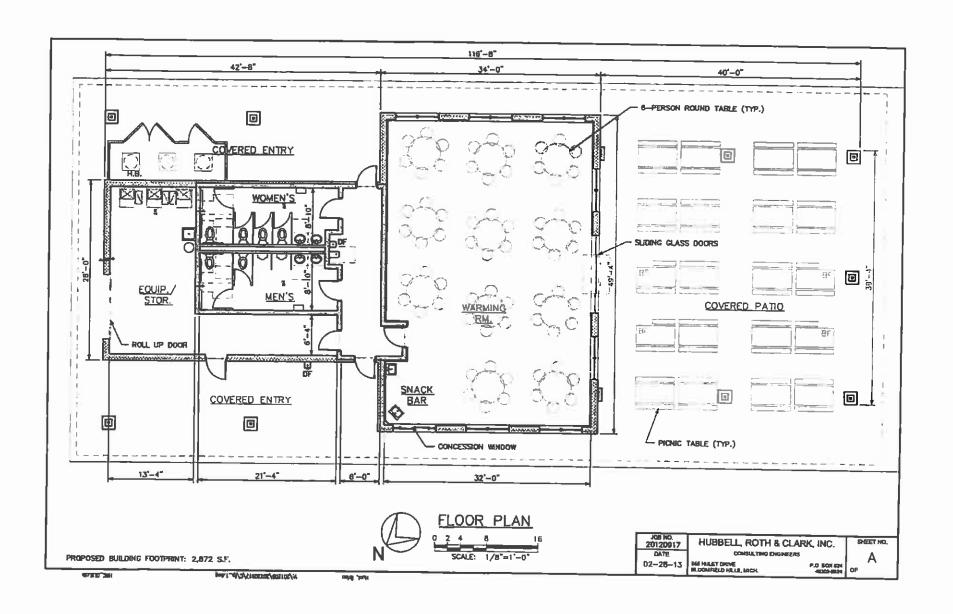


Park Comfort Station—Northwest View

Attached please find sketch and sample of the sign layout that we are suggesting for all IGA Grant projects. The Specs are as follows:

- Sign size: 48" x 30" 3/4" marine grade plywood.
- Sign is to be one-sided. Two-sided is optional.
- To be out with "Carriage" style top...i.e., arched. (optional).
- Color options up to you; 1, 2, 3 or 4 color...it's totally up to you; of course, more colors, more cost involved.
- Font should be traditional styles in Helvetica, Arial, Times New Roman, something standard.
- Include County Logo, County Executive and Commissioners, bottom left.
- Include City Logo, Mayor and City Council, bottom right.
- Parks and Rec Logo above project name.
- We suggest using 3M Reflective Adhesive water-proof vinyl. Painting is optional.
- Vertical posts shall be 4 x 6" weather-proof timbers routed on 4" side to accommodate the sign. Staining of posts optional.
- Bury post minimum of 42" into ground and backfill with dirt and compact. Concrete footing is optional.
- Bottom of sign shall be 2 ft. min above grade.
- Sign will be secured to posts with flat head Galv. wood screws (approx. #10) 2 per post (min).
- Proof to be provided of final design prior to fabrication and Installation.

#### **SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT 8 TO ORDINANCE NO.1016**

#### **OPEN HOUSE PARTY ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH REGULATING OPEN HOUSE PARTIES; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR PROHIBITIONS AND REQUIRED ACTION; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH ORDAINS:

Ordinance No. 1016, the Open House Party Ordinance, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

#### **SECTION I. TITLE.**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Open House Party Ordinance."

#### **SECTION II. ORDINANCE.**

**Section A. Definitions.** This section provides for the definition of words used in this ordinance.

**Section B. Open House Party Prohibited.** This section provides for the prohibition of open house parties.

#### **SECTION III. PENALTY.**

This section provides that any person or entity that violates any provision of this Ordinance may, upon conviction, be fined not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or imprisoned not more than Ninety (90) days, or both, in the discretion of the court.

#### **SECTION IV. REPEAL.**

This section provides that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

#### SECTION V. SEVERABILITY.

This section provides that any unenforceable section can be severed from the rest of the Ordinance.

#### **SECTION VI. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

This section provides that adoption of this Ordinance does not affect proceedings, prosecutions for violation of law, penalties and matured rights and duties in effect before the effective date of this Ordinance.

# AMENDMENT 8 TO ORDINANCE 1016 OPEN HOUSE PARTY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH REGULATING OPEN HOUSE PARTIES; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR PROHIBITIONS AND REQUIRED ACTION; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH ORDAINS:

Ordinance No. 1016, the Open House Party Ordinance, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

#### **SECTION I. TITLE.**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Open House Party Ordinance."

#### SECTION II. ORDINANCE.

#### Section A. Definitions.

(1) As used in this section:

**Alcoholic beverage** means an alcoholic liquor as defined in section 105 the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998 (MCL 436.1105 et seq.).

**Allow** means to give permission for, or approval of, possession or consumption of an alcoholic beverage or a controlled substance, by any of the following means:

- (a) In writing.
- (b) By one or more oral statements.
- (c) By any form of conduct, including a failure to take corrective action, that would cause a reasonable person to believe that permission or approval has been given.

**Control over any premises, residence, or other real property** means the authority to regulate, direct, restrain, superintend, control, or govern the conduct of other individuals on or within that premises, residence, or other real property, and includes, but is not limited to, a possessory right.

**Controlled substance** means that term as defined in section 7104 of Public Act No. 368 of 1978 (MCL 333.7104).

#### **Corrective action** means any of the following:

- (a) Making a prompt demand that the minor or other individual depart from the premises, residence, or other real property, or refrain from the unlawful possession or consumption of the alcoholic beverage or controlled substance on or within that premises, residence, or other real property, and taking additional action described in subsection (2) or (3) of this definition if the minor or other individual does not comply with the request.
- (b) Making a prompt report of the unlawful possession or consumption of alcoholic liquor or a controlled substance to a law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the violation.
- (c) Making a prompt report of the unlawful possession or consumption of alcoholic liquor or a controlled substance to another person having a greater degree of authority or control over the conduct of persons on or within the premises, residence, or other real property.

*Minor* means an individual less than 21 years of age.

**Premises** means a permanent or temporary place of assembly, other than a residence, including, but not limited to, any of the following:

- (a) A meeting hall, meeting room, or conference room.
- (b) A public or private park.
- (c) A building or structure, including its curtilage.

**Residence** means a permanent or temporary place of dwelling and its curtilage, including, but not limited to, any of the following:

- (a) A house, apartment, condominium, or mobile home.
- (b) A cottage, cabin, trailer, or tent.
- (c) A motel unit, hotel unit, or bed and breakfast unit.

**Social gathering** means an assembly of two or more individuals for any purpose, unless all of the individuals attending the assembly are members of the same household or immediate family.

#### Section B. Open House Party Prohibited.

- (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, an owner, tenant, or other person having control over any premises, residence, or other real property shall not do either of the following:
  - (a) Knowingly allow a minor to consume or possess an alcoholic beverage at a social gathering on or within that premises, residence, or other real property.
  - (b) Knowingly allow any individual to consume or possess a controlled substance at a social gathering on or within that premises, residence, or other real property.
- (2) This section does not apply to the use, consumption, or possession of a controlled substance by an individual pursuant to a lawful prescription, or to the use, consumption, or possession of an alcoholic beverage by a minor for religious purposes.
- (3) Evidence of all of the following gives rise to a rebuttable presumption that the defendant allowed the consumption or possession of an alcoholic beverage or a controlled substance on or within the premises, residence, or other real property, in violation of this section:
  - (a) The defendant had control over the premises, residence, or other real property.
  - (b) The defendant knew that a minor was consuming or in possession of an alcoholic beverage or knew that an individual was consuming or in possession of a controlled substance at a social gathering on or within that premises, residence, or other real property.
  - (c) The defendant failed to take corrective action.
- (4) This section does not authorize selling or furnishing an alcoholic beverage to a minor.
- (5) A criminal penalty provided for under this section may be imposed in addition to any penalty that may be imposed for any other criminal offense arising from the same conduct.

#### **SECTION III. PENALTY.**

- (A) A person commits a misdemeanor if the person fails to comply with or violates any of the requirements of this Ordinance.
- (B) An offense punishable under this Article is punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 and up to 90 days imprisonment in the County jail or both. A second or subsequent conviction for violation of this Article is punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$500 and up to 90 day imprisonment in the County jail or both.
- (C) In addition to prosecution, the Township may employ such other equitable or administrative procedures or enforcement remedies that shall be available to stop and/or correct the conduct involved in the offense.

#### **SECTION IV. REPEAL.**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, except as herein provided, are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

#### **SECTION V. SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

#### SECTION VI. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

The repeal or amendment herein shall not abrogate or affect any offense or act committed or done, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any pending litigation or prosecution of any right established or occurring prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, as amended.

#### SECTION VII. PUBLICATION.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH REGULATING FIREWORKS; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR PERMIT OR REGISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR DISCHARGE OF NOVELTIES; PROVIDING FOR PYROTECHNIC DISPLAYS; PROVIDING FOR PERMIT FOR DISCHARGE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH ORDAINS:

Ordinance No. 1016, the Fireworks Ordinance is hereby adopted to read as follows:

#### **SECTION I. TITLE.**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Fireworks Ordinance."

#### SECTION II. ORDINANCE.

- **Sec. A.** <u>Definitions</u>. This section provides for the definition of words used in this ordinance.
- **Sec. B. Exemptions.** This section provides that a permit is not required for the possession, ignition or discharge of novelties or low-impact fireworks.
- **Sec. C.** <u>Permit or registration required</u>. This section provides that in order to sell fireworks a consumer fireworks certificate must be obtained from the township in accordance with the requirements of Act 256, as amended.
- **Sec. D.** <u>Discharge or novelties, low-impact fireworks and consumer fireworks</u>. This section provides for the requirements and prohibitions for the discharge of novelties, low-impact fireworks and consumer fireworks.

- **Sec. E.** <u>Permit for pyrotechnic displays or other use</u>. This section provides for the requirements to obtain a permit from the township for pyrotechnic displays or other uses.
- **Sec. F.** <u>Permit for discharge of consumer fireworks</u>. This section provides for the requirements to obtain a permit from the township for the discharge of consumer fireworks.
- **Sec. G.** <u>Transportation and storage</u>. This section provides that the transportation and storage of fireworks shall be in accordance with the requirements set forth in Act 256.

### SECTION III. VIOLATION AND PENALTY.

This section provides that any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance is responsible for a civil infraction punishable by a civil fine not to exceed \$500.00.

#### **SECTION IV. REPEAL.**

This section provides that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

#### **SECTION V. SEVERABILITY.**

This section provides that any unenforceable section can be severed from the rest of the Ordinance.

### THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH ORDAINS:

Amendment 9 to Ordinance No. 1016, the Fireworks Ordinance. is hereby adopted to read as follows:

#### **SECTION I. TITLE.**

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Fireworks Ordinance."

#### SECTION II. ORDINANCE.

#### Sec. A. <u>Definitions</u>.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this division, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Act 256 shall mean Act 256 of the Public Acts of 2011, being MCL 28.451.

Articles pyrotechnic shall mean pyrotechnic devices for professional use that are similar to consumer fireworks in chemical composition and construction, but are not intended for consumer use, that meet the weight limits for consumer fireworks, but are not labeled as such, and that are classified as UN0431 or UN0432 under 49 CFR 172.101.

Consumer fireworks shall mean firework devices that are designed to provide visible effects by combustion, that are required to comply with the construction chemical composition, and labeling regulations promulgated by the United States consumer product safety commission under 16 CFR parts 1500 and 1507, and are listed in APA

standard 87-1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3, or 3.5. Consumer fireworks do not include low-impact fireworks.

Consumer fireworks certificate or certificate shall mean a certificate issued under Section 28.467a of Act 256.

Department shall mean the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.

*Display fireworks* shall mean large fireworks devices that are explosive materials intended for use in fireworks displays and designed to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation, as provided in 27 CFR 555.11, 49 CFR 172, and APA standard 87-1, 4.1.

Fireworks shall mean any composition or device, except for a starting pistol, a flare gun, or a flare designed for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, deflagration, or detonation. Fireworks consist of consumer fireworks, low impact fireworks, articles pyrotechnic, display fireworks, and special effects.

Low-impact fireworks shall mean ground and handheld sparkling devices as that phrase is defined under APA standard 87-1, 3.1, 3.1.1.1 to 3.1.1.8, and 3.5.

*Novelties* shall mean the term defined under APA standard 87-1, 3.2, 3.2.1, 3.2.2, 3.2.3, 3.2.4, and 3.2.5 and all of the following:

- (1) Toy plastic or paper caps for toy pistols in sheets, strips, rolls, or individual caps containing not more than .25 of a grain of explosive content per cap, in packages labeled to indicate the maximum explosive content per cap.
- (2) Toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, toy trick noisemakers, and toy guns in which toy caps as described in subparagraph (i) are used, that are constructed so that the hand cannot come in contact with the cap when in place for the explosion, and that are not designed to break apart or be separated so as to form a missile by the explosion.
- (3) Flitter sparklers in paper tubes not exceeding 1/8 inch in diameter.

National holiday shall mean the following legal holidays:

- (1) New Years' Day, January 1
- (2) Martin Luther King, Jr., Day, the third Monday in January
- (3) George Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in February
- (4) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
- (5) Independence Day, July 4
- (6) Labor Day, the first Monday in September
- (7) Columbus Day, the second Monday in October
- (8) Veteran's Day, November 11

- (9) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November
- (10) Christmas Day, December 25.

*Person* shall include an individual, agent, association, charitable organization, company, limited liability company, corporation, labor organization, legal representative, partnership, unincorporated association, or any other legal or commercial entity.

Special effects shall mean a combination of chemical elements or chemical compounds capable of burning independently of the oxygen of the atmosphere and designed and intended to produce an audible, visual, mechanical, or thermal effect as an integral part of a motion picture, radio, television, theatrical, or opera production or live entertainment.

#### Sec. B. Exemptions.

A permit is not required under this division for the possession, ignition or discharge of novelties or low-impact fireworks. A permit for the discharge of consumer fireworks may be required under section F.

#### Sec. C. Permit or registration required.

- (1) No person shall sell consumer fireworks in the township without having obtained a consumer fireworks certificate from the department as required by, and complied with all the requirements of Act 256, as amended. The consumer fireworks certificate shall be prominently displayed at the retail location for which the certificate was issued.
- (2) No person shall sell low-impact fireworks without having registered with the low impact fireworks retail registry maintained by the department.

# Sec. D. <u>Discharge or novelties, low-impact fireworks and consumer fireworks.</u>

- (1) Except in the case of a consumer permit issued by the township under section F, consumer fireworks and low-impact fireworks shall not be ignited, discharged, or used by any person at any time, except on the day preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday. On these holiday dates only, the ignition, discharge or use of consumer fireworks and low-impact fireworks is permitted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight) only, except that consumer fireworks and low-impact fireworks shall be permitted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. on New Year's Eve, and always only in accordance with state and local law.
- (2) When permitted, consumer fireworks and low-impact fireworks shall not be ignited or discharged on public property, school property, church property, or property of another person without that organization's or person's written permission to use consumer fireworks on the premises.

- (3) No fireworks shall be ignited or discharged within 70 feet of any building, or on any public street.
- (4) Minors shall be prohibited from possessing, using, igniting or discharging consumer fireworks.
- (5) No person shall use low-impact or consumer fireworks while under the influence of alcoholic liquor or a controlled substance or both.

#### Sec. E. Permit for pyrotechnic displays or other use.

- (1) The township board, upon application in writing, on forms provided by the department may grant a permit for the use of fireworks otherwise prohibited by section D, within the township, manufactured for outdoor pest control or agricultural purposes, or for public display by municipalities, fair associations, amusement parks, or other organizations or groups of individuals approved by the township board, if the applicable provisions of this division and the Act are complied with. After a permit has been granted, the possession or transportation of fireworks for the purposes described in the permit only may be made. A permit granted under this subsection shall not be transferable, nor shall a permit be issued to a person under the age of 18 years.
- (2) Before a permit for articles pyrotechnic or display fireworks is issued, the person making application therefor shall furnish proof of financial responsibility by a bond or insurance in an amount deemed necessary by the township board, to satisfy claims for damages to property or personal injuries arising out of an act or omission on the part of the person, or any agent or employee thereof, in the amount, character and form the township board determines necessary for the protection of the public.
- (3) No permit shall be issued under this section to a nonresident person for conduct of articles pyrotechnic or display fireworks until such person has appointed in writing a resident member of the bar of this state or a resident agent to be his legal representative upon whom all process in an action or proceeding against him may be served.
- (4) The township board shall rule on the competency and qualifications of operators of articles pyrotechnic or display fireworks as the operator has furnished in his application form, and on the time, place and safety aspects of the displays, before granting permits.

#### Sec. F. <u>Permit for discharge of consumer fireworks</u>.

- (1) Persons wishing to discharge consumer fireworks on a day other than the day preceding, day of, or day after a national holiday shall do so only after paying a fee and obtaining a permit from the township.
- (2) Application for a permit to discharge consumer fireworks under this section shall be made on forms available from the township clerk.

- (3) Approval of a permit to discharge consumer fireworks shall be subject to the following minimum conditions:
  - (i) A minimum radial setback of 70 foot per one inch of the largest aerial device proposed to be discharged from the proposed launch site to the nearest occupied structure.
  - (ii) Satisfactory inspection by the fire prevention division of the township fire department upon delivery of the consumer fireworks to the proposed launch site.
  - (iii) Written permission of the property owner, if different than the applicant, shall be provided.
  - (iv) Additional reasonable conditions the fire prevention division deems necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
- (4) A permit under this section shall not be issued to a minor.
- (5) A permit shall not be issued for any public property, including roads, road rights-of-way, or sidewalks.
- (6) The required inspection shall be requested by the applicant not later than 24 hours prior to the proposed discharge. For a proposed discharge on a Saturday or Sunday, the request shall be made not later than 8:30 a.m. of the Thursday preceding the proposed day of discharge.

#### Sec. G. <u>Transportation and storage</u>.

Transportation and storage of fireworks through and in the township shall be in accordance with the requirements set forth in Act 256.

### SECTION III. VIOLATION AND PENALTY.

Unless otherwise provided, any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance is responsible for a civil infraction punishable by a civil fine not to exceed \$500.00.

#### **SECTION IV. REPEAL.**

This section provides that any unenforceable section can be severed from the rest of the Ordinance.

#### **AMENDMENT 10 TO ORDINANCE NO. 1017**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH TO AMEND ORDINANCE 1016 BY REVISING THE USE FACTOR SCHEDULE, CODIFIED SECTION X-3.055 OF SECTION I, ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER X OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REVISION OF THE USE FACTOR SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF PLYMOUTH ORDAINS:

#### <u>SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE.</u>

Ordinance No. 1016, codified as Section X-3.055 of Section I, Article 3, Chapter X, the Water and Sewer System Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### X-3.055. Use Factor Schedule.

(A) Use factor units for the fees enumerated in Sections X-3.04 and X-3.050 will be calculated as follows:

Convalescent homes	1.00 unit plus 0.50 unit per bed
Factories / Manufacturing	0.50 unit per 1,000 sq. ft.
Fitness center / health club without showers & pool	0.30 unit per 1,000 sq. ft.
Fitness center/ health club with showers & pool	2.00 unit per 1,000 sq. ft.
Fraternal organizations	2.00 unit per dwelling

(B) When primary uses contain other secondary uses the total factor shall be the summation of the applicable separate factors, (e.g.: bowling alley factor + bar factor + restaurant factor = total factor). Use factors for uses that do not, in the township's opinion, fit the descriptions listed above will be determined by the Township Board.

#### SECTION II. REPEAL.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, except as herein provided, are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

#### SECTION III. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

#### **SECTION IV. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

The repeal or amendment herein shall not abrogate or affect any offense or act committed or done, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any pending litigation or prosecution of any right established or occurring prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, as amended.

#### **SECTION V. PUBLICATION.**

The Clerk for the Charter Township of Plymouth shall cause this Ordinance to be published in the manner required by law.
