### **Notification of Block Party**

Regulations:

The Plymouth Township Police Department is happy to comply with your request for barricading a public street in order for you and your neighbors to participate in a block party; however, you must follow the rules listed below for the protection of lives and property:

1. The street is not to be barricaded with any immovable objects such as motor vehicles, trailers, etc. You must use lightweight wooden barricades or traffic cones. You may make arrangements to use Township wooden barricades by contacting the Plymouth Township DPW at (734) 414-1443 at least four (4) days prior to the block party. The Plymouth Township DPW office is located at 9955 N. Haggerty Rd.
2. Place the wooden barricades at each end of the block. Do not block the street in a manner that would prevent emergency vehicles from having ready access to any home or injured person.
3. Notify all residents in that are in participating in the party that they cannot drive to and from their houses during the block party; they should move their vehicles to another location prior to the start of the party if access is required.
4. Fireworks use is prohibited – use of such will exclude future block parties.
5. Plymouth Township residents need to adhere to all noise ordinance requirements. Disturbance calls to the police department will jeopardize future requests for block parties.
