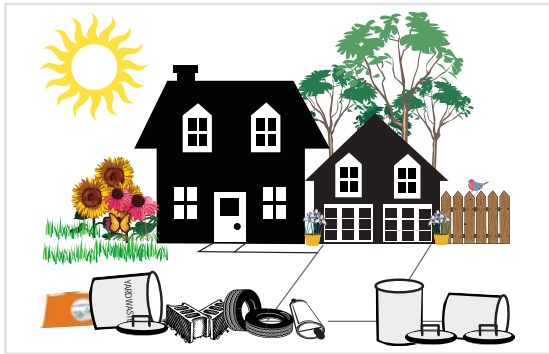
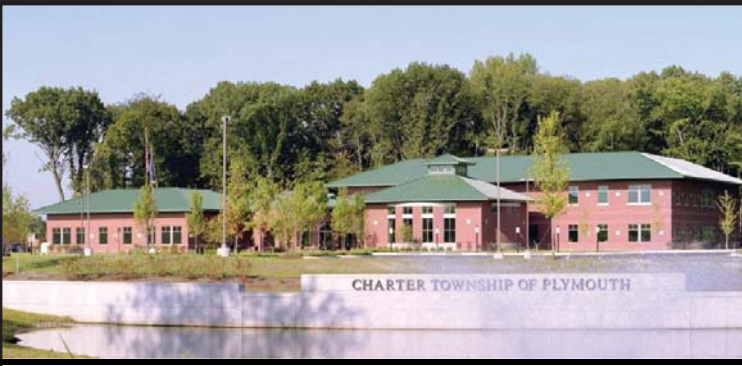

Our residential Solid Waste Contractor will collect most items curbside, but there are certain materials that cannot be collected, or in some cases, can only be taken in smaller amounts. This may be because the item may damage the trucks, potentially harm the sanitation worker, or are banned from being placed in the landfill by state or federal law.

- Completely submerge fireworks in a large bucket of water and soak until thoroughly saturated. This may take 15 minutes for small fireworks or as long as overnight for larger ones.
- Double wrap the completely soaked fireworks in plastic wrap or two plastic bags so they do not dry out.
- Place the double-bagged fireworks in the household trash.
