Sealed "Timber Sale Bid" (so marked on the envelope) will be received by the Polk County Forest Administrator on behalf of the Polk County Environmental Services Committee (ESC) for timber stumpage on designated areas of the Polk County Forest. Bids will be accepted up to **1pm on Tuesday, April 30**<sup>th</sup> at the Polk County Forest Administrator's office, ground floor Room G11 of the Polk County Government Center, Balsam Lake, WI. Mailed bids must be received on or before Tuesday, April 30th, 2024. Furthermore, bids will be opened publicly by the Polk County Forest Administrator and the WI DNR Liaison Forester. The results of the bids will be shared as soon as possible.

Bids will be opened at 1:30 pm, Tuesday, April, 2024, on the second floor North Conference Room of the Polk County Government Center, Balsam Lake, WI. Sales will be awarded by the Environmental Services Committee (ESC) at the 9:00am regular meeting on May 1st, 2024. Polk County ESC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids determined to be in the best interest of Polk County.

#### **BIDS**

- Bids must be made separately for each tract by species and product on the standard form provided and must be plainly marked on the outside of the envelope "SEALED TIMBER BID, TRACT #\_\_\_\_".
  - \*\*Please note the following\*\*

Tracts 2-23 and 5-23 are being sold as Lump Sum. All other tracts are being sold as mill scale.

- - O The winning bidder must sign a sale contract and produce a performance bond within 45 days of the bid being awarded by the ESC or the bidder will be ineligible for bidding on sales for two years. Polk County will require a performance bond (15% of the total bid value or \$1,000.00 whichever is greater) as a performance security.
    - Letters of Credit, a Certified, Personal, or Cashier's Check, Bank or Postal Money order payable to Polk County Forestry Department are acceptable.
      - Letters of Credit must have an <u>expiration date of June 30, 2027.</u>

### **CONTRACT PERIOD and EXTENSIONS**

- All contracts will expire on JUNE 30, 2026. Contract extensions are not guaranteed.
- If the Seller deems extensions of this Contract reasonable, the stumpage price agreed upon herein shall be adjusted as follows:

a. First extension: 1 year 5% increase

b. Second extension: 1 year 15% increase

#### **INSURANCE**

An original certificate of insurance covering liability insurance, workers' compensation and motor vehicle insurance is required to be filed with the County's sale prior to the beginning of any work on the contract area. Worker's compensation coverage shall not be waived if statutorily required and all worker's compensation insurance policies shall satisfy the Wisconsin statutory minimum limits. The contractor must add "County of Polk, its officers, employees, and agents" as a certificate holder under the commercial general, automobile and contractor's pollution liability and workers' compensation policies.

#### TRAINING STANDARD

Polk County requires appropriate training of its logging contactors. Successful purchasers of Polk County Forest stumpage will need to ensure that the logging contractor complies with the **Wisconsin Sustainable Forestry Initiative®** Training Standard as adopted by the Wisconsin SFI Implementation Committee (SIC). Criteria for the standard can be found at: <a href="http://www.fistausa.org/become-sfi.html">http://www.fistausa.org/become-sfi.html</a>. Documentation confirming completion of the training standard will be required prior to any work on the contract area.

Polk County Forestry is third party certified.

### **SALES**

The County reserves the right to either accept mill scale or to scale wood on the site. Sale volumes are estimates and are not guaranteed. Hardwood sawlogs are defined as being at least 8' long and taken to a 10" diameter inside bark (dib) on the small end. Logs will be scaled at the sale site using Scribner Decimal C log rule unless a Mill scale slip can be provided. 'Hand' or 'stick' scaled wood will be converted according to the WDNR Timber Sale Handbook table below (please note mixed hardwood is added by Polk County):

The lock box ticket system will be used for all scaled sales unless otherwise stated on the individual sale map. Copies of all mill scale slips shall be provided to the Polk County Forestry Department. Arrangements will be made to scale all saw timber and products for which mill scale slips cannot be obtained.

Polk County requires prepayment on all sales before cutting may begin. The purchaser will be subject to a 5% interest charge per month on payments not received within 30 calendar days of any invoice amount. Payment schedules are listed in the timber sale contract. A sample timber sale contract is available upon request.

For all Polk County timber sales located in Sterling Township, only bark free Oak trees, Oak trees with loose bark, or downed Oak trees for a year or longer may be sold to private individuals. The purpose of this restriction is to avoid spreading Oak Wilt to surrounding areas.

Wisconsin Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) for Water Quality, Wisconsin Forestry BMPs for Invasive Species AND Wisconsin Forestry BMPs for Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines will be followed. Rutting and other excessive soil damage will result in ceasing operations.

No whole tree harvesting allowed unless otherwise stated on the individual sale map.

# NO TIMBER SALE MAY BEGIN <u>WITHOUT A MEETING</u> WITH THE POLK COUNTY FOREST ADMINISTRATOR OR DNR FORESTER AT THE SALE SITE.

\*Building of roads and/or landings must be approved by the Forest Administrator or the DNR Forester before construction.





# 2024 Polk County Timber Sales - Town of Lorain



#### **Cutting Requirements / Information**

- 1. Harvest all Stems greater than 2 inches in diameter except leave all small nonmerchantable jack pine. Leave any dead snags that are not a hazard.
- 2. Sale is bound by blue paint, red paint or ATV trail. ATV trail/trailhead may not be used for forestry operations.
- 3. Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees and limbs that will make at least 1, 100" pulp stick 4 inches on small end.
- 4. Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground. Do not pile or windrow.
- 5. Any landings, new access roads, or turn-arounds must be approved by County Forest Administrator.
- 6. This is a scaled sale for all products. Mill scale with haul ticket system will be used. County reserves right to scale on the landing. No guarantee that sale will cut out as estimated.

<u>Description of Stumpage:</u> Jack pine is of average to very good quality. Aspen is poor to average quality for Sterling. Oak is short and average to poor. Stand has been dozer scarified for jack pine regeneration. Access to sale will need to be cut or bladed out through young oak and jack pine from existing landing. Volume estimate by variable radius plot – sampling error 18%.



- 1. Area 1 Harvest all stems greater than 2 inches in diameter except leave all pine.
- 2. Area 2 Harvest all/only merchantable stems.
- 3. Area 3 Harvest all stems greater than 2 inches in diameter except leave all pine.
- 4. No cutting with 100 feet of private blue line on area 1 between April 15 and July 15.
- 5. Harvest of dead oak is encouraged but optional. Dead oak is not included in volume estimate.
- 6. Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees and limbs that will make at least 1, 100" pulp stick 4 inches on small end.
- 7. Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground. Do not pile or windrow.
- 8. Any landings, new access roads, or turn-arounds must be approved by County Forest Administrator.
- 9. Due to active oak wilt, no sales to private parties unless bark is loose or wood is 1 year old.
- 10. This is a Lump Sum sale for all products. No guarantee that sale will cut out as estimated.

<u>Description of Stumpage:</u> Oak is mostly large diameter, quality mixed. Mixed hardwood quality is average for Sterling. Active oak wilt pockets. Access is good for both blocks but old roads will need to be opened up. Sampling error averages about 20% for all products.



- Harvest all stems greater than 2 inches in diameter except leave all jack pine less than 7" in diameter and oak greater than 20" in diameter. Leave all snags that do not pose a hazard to operations.
- Sale is bound by red paint, unimproved road boundary, 290th Ave and 330th Ave.
- Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees and limbs that will make at least 1 100" pulp stick 4 inches on small end.
- Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground.
- No cutting, hauling, or forwarding during wet periods when rutting occurs.
- Due to the likely presence of oak wilt, no oak shall be sold to private individuals unless the bark is loose, off or is a year old.



- Harvest all stems greater than 2 inches in diameter except leave all green marked trees, non-merchantable birch and yellow blazed trees associated with the Ice Age Trail. Leave all snags that do not pose a hazard to operations.
- Sale is bound by red paint, blue paint, field edge and the Ice Age Trail.
- -No harvesting breakup through July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- -No slash, felling or equipment allowed across blue paint line onto private property at any time.
- -No equipment within 15' of wetland edges during non-frozen time of year.
- Utilization: Utilize all harvested trees and limbs that will make at least 1 100" pulp stick 4 inches on small end.
- Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 3 feet of the ground.
- No cutting, hauling, or forwarding during wet periods when rutting occurs.

### **Ice Age Trail Requirements**

- Slash to be removed daily from the trail.
- Do not damage or cut yellow markers or signage associated with the trail.



- Unimproved forest roads may need improvement if utilized for hauling.
- -One temporary culvert replacement required by purchaser.
- Permission through private land off of 310<sup>th</sup> Ave might be available.
- Permitted temporary stream crossings with equipment may be needed to access northern units, unless ground is frozen or access granted by private.
- Leave all snags that do not pose a safety threat to logging operations.
