<u>Planning Commission.</u> Two 3-year terms. The new terms will begin in January 2024. The Planning Commission meets the fourth Tuesday of every month beginning at 5:30 p.m. in the Red Bluff City Council Chambers.

<u>Parks & Recreation Commission.</u> One 1-year Student Representative term and one 3-year term. The new terms will begin in January 2024. The Parks & Recreation Commission meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Red Bluff City Council Chambers.

<u>Airport Commission.</u> Two 3-year terms. The new terms will begin in January 2024. The Airport Commission meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the Red Bluff City Council Chambers.

<u>Audit Committee - Citizen Member.</u> One 1-year term. The new term will begin in January 2024. The Audit Committee meets as needed, usually 2-3 times per year.

<u>Loan Committee Member for Economic CDBG/HOME Loans & Program Income</u> <u>Loans.</u> *One* – 1-year term. The new term will begin in January 2024. This committee meets as needed.

Citizens who volunteer their time to serve on local government commissions are required to complete and file a Statement of Economic Interest (Form 700) with the City Clerk's Office.
