 During the Tehama County Board of Supervisors meeting on September 10th, Gary Walker was appointed to the Airport Land Use Commission to fill Lynn Chamblin's unexpired term as the City of Red Bluff representative with said term expiring 9/30/22.

- 5.4 Recent Inspections at RBL
 On September 25, staff met with CalTrans Division of Aeronautics on the field for the Annual 5010 and Permit Compliance inspection. Correction notices included faded taxiway centerlines and hold-bars, faded illuminated runway markers, and requirement to remove helipad from TWY B. The items listed are all part of the next planned ACIP. PG&E conducted their gas line testing where it crosses just south of the RWY 33 threshold on the following morning. No anomalies were indicated.


6 New Business

- CalFire and USFS use of RBL for Fire Support Informational
 The recent Red Bank, South, and Ranch Fires found CalFire and USFS utilizing an extensive area of RBL, including a taxiway closure and installation of a temporary tower for air traffic control. Up to 33 additional helicopters and support crews were based on the field with various additional CalFire and USFS ground personnel present for the duration of the fires. CalFire, USFS, and tower commended the local pilots and voiced their appreciation for Red Bluff providing a welcome environment. Staff has been in contact with multiple agency representatives to formulate a delineated "pre-plan" for aerial asset staging for future fire-fighting occupations of RBL. A meeting will occur during the winter months when the fire threat is reduced, to discuss the generation of a plan and map that will meet the needs of both RBL and multi-agency emergency assets.
- 6.2 **Proposed 72' x 52' x 18' eave ht. Hangar Addition**A proposed 3,848 square foot new hangar building has been submitted to the City that would be an addition to an existing hangar located at 1910 Hornbeck Street. Staff requests comments and recommendations from the Airport Commission prior to completion of review and return to applicant. See attached **Exhibit A**.
- 6.3 **Commissioner Term Expirations**Two Commissioner's 3-year appointments will be expiring at the end of December, Wanda Schuler and Dave Cappello's. A statement of intent for reappointment or new applications must be received by the Deputy City Clerk no later than 16:00 on November 22, 2019 to be considered for appointment at the December 3, 2019 City Council Meeting.
