The City has been awarded various additional FAA grants in relation to federal response to the pandemic. The different grants have unique criteria and restrictions for their applicability and use. Staff is requesting recommendations as to how and where the grants may be applied at the airport. Grants received to date are **CARES** (\$30,000) - *operations, maintence, and replace in-kind components*, **CRRSA** (\$23,000) – *combating spread of pathogens*, **ARPA** (\$59,000) - *utility costs or low emission equipment used to combat spread of pathogens*. The **Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, Airport Allocations** grant is anticipated to be offered soon, where RBL is expected to receive \$295,000 for AIP type projects.
