WHAT IS ARPA?

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (H.R. 1319) into law. The \$1.9 trillion package, based on President Biden's American Rescue Plan, is intended to combat the COVID-19 pandemic, including the public health and economic impacts. Saginaw has received \$52 million to reinvest into the city.

Allocation Options:

- Improvement to Parks and Trails (Ojibway Island, Wickes Park, Iron Belle Trail, Riverfront Gateway, etc.)
- Public Infrastructure (roads, sidewalk repairs, cemetery improvements, city facilities, water/sewer, technological, etc.)
- Housing to Promote Neighborhood Revitalization (housing rehabilitation and repair, affordable housing, housing loan programs)
- Crime and Fire Prevention
- City Beautification (blight elimination, neighborhood cleanup, tree removal, curbside removal, grass cutting)
- Economic Development Opportunities (grants to small businesses, facade improvements)
- Healthcare Development to Increase Access to All
- Increase Funding for Social Programs and Non-Profit Agencies

TODAY'S DISCUSSION

The meeting will be facilitated by Tim Dempsey, Vice President of Public Sector Consultants. An overview of the ARPA funding and eligible expenses will be included in the presentation, as well as the official City of Saginaw ARPA survey results.

Council will focus their discussion on strategic investments of ARPA funding that will advance the prosperity and quality of life for Saginaw residents.
