February 13, 2020

1. CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Regional Law Enforcement Committee (Committee) was called to order by Chairman Alegria at 8:05 a.m. in the Council Chamber at Rolling Hills City Hall, 2 Portuguese Bend Road, Rolling Hills, California.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Member Wilson led the pledge of allegiance.

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Susan Brooks congratulated Member Bradley for his new appointment as Councilmember and Committee member. She requested that public comments for agenda items be made available for public participants to provide their input. She shared that residents were experiencing confusion because of the Cal-Water construction project lane changes and that residents were receiving mobbing violation tickets from the Sheriff. Ms. Brooks requested that the cities work with the Sheriff to further educate the public so that there would be less confusion and less tickets issued. Another comment was in regards to the switchbacks along Palos Verdes Drive East and South. She noted that the City of Rancho Palos Verdes (RPV) City Council allocated an additional Sheriff Officer to target the switchbacks, as there were several accidents and one death that occurred in the previous month. With these deaths and accidents, Ms. Brooks requested that they future such events should be shared to the newspaper.

5. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

A. MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 13, 2020

Member Wilson moved, seconded by Chairman Algeria, to approve the Minutes of the February 13, 2020 Regional Law Enforcement Committee Meeting. Motion approved without objection, (8-0).

6. COMMITTEE REORGANIZATION

Member Schmitz formally congratulated Councilmember Mitchell for her service towards the region and the Committee. On behalf of Councilmember Mitchell, Member Schmitz nominated Mayor Pro Tem Alegria, seconded by Member Wilson, to become the next Chair of the Regional Law Enforcement Committee. Motion approved without objection, (8-0).

In response to Member Bradley's question regarding the reason the City of Palos Verdes Estates (PVE) is not a part of this meeting, Chair Alegria explained that the Committee includes the cities with Los Angeles Sheriff's Department contracts. Interim City Manager Mihranian added that the Committee was formed to enhance communication between the three cities that contract with the Sheriff's Department. City Manager Grammer also shared that the Committee focuses on the crime statistics, and the Committee also recognized in the past that emergency preparedness is different and should include all four cities, which is the reason the Regional Emergency Preparedness Committee was created. Chair Alegria suggested having this discussion as a future agenda item.

7. OLD BUSINESS

A. UPDATE ON SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER (VERBAL REPORT)

Keith Butler, Associate Superintended, Business Services for the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District (PVPUSD), passed out a written update and explained that billing is still being worked out between the security firm and the cities. Mr. Butler introduced the two School Resource Officers (SRO): Dave Rozas and Steve Moses. Mr. Steve Moses provided his background, which includes 30 years with the Sheriff's Department, working alongside Captain Powers, and past experience as a School Resource Office at Lakewood High School.

In response to Interim City Manager Mihranian's request, Mr. Moses provided an explanation of his daily duties and overall responsibilities. Each day, he checks reports from the evening before to the morning he arrives. He also serves as a traffic officer, performs perimeter, bathroom and car checks, stops outsiders from coming into the open campus, and builds relationships and trust with the students and parents.

In response to Member Schmitz's question whether they monitor students' social media, Mr. Moses explained that they assess and respond to incidents when necessary, but do not actively monitor social media accounts. Associate Superintendent Butler also shared that the school district cannot monitor social media due to liability reasons, but they respond when they are made aware of an incident.

In response to Chair Alegria regarding when the district responds to an incident escalation, Associate Superintendent Butler explained that they would respond when an incident was made aware to them.

In response to Member Bradley's question regarding if the threat of posting explicit pictures is a crime, Mr. Moses stated that the threat itself is not a crime.

In response to Member Dieringer regarding the start time of the SRO's shift, placement of the SRO, camera monitoring on campus, and the amount of time for physical checks throughout the school hours, Mr. Moses explained that they have an office at the backend of the open campus school, they have twelve cameras that can be monitored on his district-provided computer, and he constantly performs physical checks across the perimeter and inside of the school. Associate Superintendent Butler also shared that there are different levels of video surveillance on each campus and that they are looking to increase safety and surveillance, pending approval of a local bond measure.

Member Schmitz shared her appreciation of the SRO and recognized their positive impact presence on the schools.

In response to Chair Alegria regarding safety topic education, Assistant Superintendent Butler shared that these will be offered as summer school projects for community education.

Associate Superintendent Butler asked the Committee to begin thinking about the following year's MOU, and that it would be ready for discussion in the next month or

two. He also shared that there is a Tobacco Grant in the State of California specifically for monitoring and lowering tobacco use. He noted that most school districts use this for SRO funding, and that the deadline for this is in July – He will follow up with the cities with the information for the grant.

In response to Member Dieringer's question regarding disciplinary actions for students at Peninsula High School and the other SRO, Mr. Rozas provided an introduction and shared his responsibilities. Mr. Rozas shared that he is a 38 year Lomita Sheriff's Station retiree who has lived in the South Bay with family who grew up in the region. He stated that they have 12 cameras with six more coming to be used at that campus. As a SRO, he also sits with the Associate Principals when discipline occurs and is available to provide recommended actions. Associate Superintendent Butler referred to the written update for other disciplinary actions.

Chair Alegria noted for the safety topics to be brought up for the next meeting.

Member Schmitz requested for written reports to be provided in advance of the meetings.

B. ALPR UPDATE (VERBAL REPORT)

Interim City Manager Mihranian provided an update on the two phases of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes' ALPR cameras along Western Avenue. He stated that phase one is currently underway and that there was a delay due to the manufacturing of the poles. The poles will be installed in spring. For the second phase, the additional cameras are being purchased and will be installed this summer.

City Manager Grammer shared the City of Rolling Hills Estates' two phase ALPR expansion. The City finished installation of new cameras on Rolling Hills Road and Crenshaw Boulevard and will shortly finish the installation of new cameras on Palos Verdes Drive East along the northern limit of the City of Lomita. In the next phase that will be taking place later in the spring or early summer, there be will additional cameras at Rolling Hills Road at the intersection of Hawthorne Boulevard and Palos Verdes Drive East along the northern limit of the City of Lomita. These locations will cover every entry point into the City of Rolling Hills Estates (RHE).

In response to Member Bradley regarding the connectivity of the ALPR system, Interim City Manager Mihranian confirmed that the ALPR systems are all connected across the Peninsula

In response to Member Schmitz to clarify whether there are cameras in PVE, Assistant City Manager Davis stated that there are cameras on Via Del Monte and along Palos Verdes Boulevard by the City Hall. Interim City Manager Mihranian added that all entry points to the Peninsula will have ALPR cameras.

In response to Member Bradley regarding whether the Lomita Sherriff's Station receives the ALPR hits from PVE Police Department, and vice versa, and if it is an integrated system, Captain Powers stated that if there is an ALPR hit within their jurisdiction heading towards the jurisdictions of Torrance Police Department, Los Angeles Police Department, and PVE Police Department, they will provide a courtesy call, and the same occurs if it is the other way around. He further clarified that each agency has the ability to continue the pursuit of an ALPR hit into the jurisdictions of other agencies.

Assistant City Manager Davis clarified that the ALPR system runs on one database through a collaboration with one vendor, Vigilant Solutions. Although the alerts may not be sent to the different jurisdictions, all the public safety agencies have the access to the same database.

In response to Member Dieringer's question regarding clarification of ALPR monitoring and if there is a way to proactively access the hits without receiving a courtesy call, Assistant City Manager Davis stated that each public safety agency has the capability to turn on alerts. Analyst Slawson also added that traffic officers have the capability to quickly communicate with one another over radio frequencies.

In response to Member Dieringer's request for an update for the next meeting, Assistant City Manager Davis noted that staff will follow-up with Vigilant Solutions for verification if every public safety agency can proactively access the ALPR cameras from other agencies.

Captain Powers stated that the ALPR systems are usually used after the fact as a means of follow-ups and investigation.

C. LOMITA STATION RECRUITMENT UPDATE (VERBAL REPORT)

Captain Powers reported a recruitment update and shared current vacancies. The Lomita Sherriff's Station has three additional Sergeants and one Lieutenant. There are no more vacancies for Lieutenants and one more vacancy for a Sergeant, although one just retired and one is on injury. Deputy vacancies are almost full and they are intentionally not taking additional trainees due to the lack of training officers.

8. NEW BUSINESS

A. QUARTERLY LAW ENFORCEMENT / TRAFFIC REPORT / CORE UPDATE

Chair Alegria requested that this update be focused on the highlights of the statistics instead of a detailed report, as was done in the past. The Committee agreed, that individual committee members can ask questions and allow the Captain to provide key highlights.

Captain Powers introduced his new Operations Sergeant Cedano who will be replacing retiring Sergeant DiGerlando. Sergeant Cedano shared that he has been with the Lomita Sheriff's Station for three years and is happy to be working with the Committee.

Captain Powers presented a summary of the highlights of the fourth quarter law enforcement update (October, December, January) for each of the cities in the Peninsula Region, with three year comparisons of the fourth quarter statistics.

For RPV, Captain Powers noted that statistics are consistent and particularly highlighted the Traffic Enforcement Index. This index uses a non-perfect mathematical formula based on 20 citations per collision; the RPV is below the 20 to 1 number, and overall, the citations are down.

In response to Member Schmitz's question regarding the extra deputies that RPV pays for on the switchbacks, Captain Powers explained that deputies intermittently patrol the switchback areas. Interim City Manager Mihranian confirmed that their contract with the Sheriff's Department includes costs for extra deputy patrols along the switchback during specific times or as requested.

In response to Member Bradley's inquiry regarding stationing of an unmanned vehicle at the top of the switchbacks, Captain Powers state that they have those available and have utilized them in the past. He explained their limited usage as they have been only useful for one day and have been vandalized in the past.

For RHE, Captain Powers noted that for the citation numbers have stemmed from the Cal Water Crenshaw Boulevard Project. He explained that his officers have been exercising the spirit of the law more than the letter of the law, in that they have been listening to individuals and allowing some of them to go.

Member Schmitz acknowledged the Sheriff's Stations and city staff efforts especially in regards to the lane changes.

For Rolling Hills (RH), Captain Powers noted that there were no traffic collisions and the index is zero due to no collisions. There were some citations, but no other notes beyond that.

Captain Powers presented a summary of the fourth quarter crime statistics (October, November, and December) for each of the cities in the Peninsula Region.

For RPV, Captain Powers stated his biggest concern is residential burglaries, which went up by seven from the previous year although there have been several arrests related to these burglaries.

In response to Chair Alegria regarding the year to year comparison, Captain Powers confirmed that the overall burglaries from 2018 to 2019 were down.

In response to Member Bradley regarding how RPV can help the Sheriff's Station, Captain Powers affirmed that the City's use of Ring camera and that any camera system is helpful and very useful. He also shared the effectiveness of "see something, say something" and that this can be further shared. Lieutenant White also shared that community buy-in and education would be helpful, especially with regards to having neighbors communicate with each other when they are on vacation. He stated that burglars usually go straight to the Master Bedroom and residents can do a better job of hiding their valuables and purchasing safes. He also stated that residents are still having trouble with locking their doors.

Interim City Manager Mihranian noted that there was an uptick of burglaries along a specific section of Western Avenue, which Captain Powers confirmed that four of the burglaries were from the same organized burglars. Lieutenant White also noted that burglaries occurring in one city may result in arrests in another city, and vice versa.

For RHE, Captain Powers stated that his biggest concern was the increase to vehicle burglaries and other larceny thefts. He explained that further community education to not leave valuables in vehicles would be helpful. He also explained that larceny theft issues have risen due to certain stores allowing individuals to shoplift more easily.

In response to Member Schmitz's inquiry regarding the definition of other larceny theft, Captain Powers explained that this category is for thefts of items that exceed the value of 950 dollars.

For part II crimes, there was one misdemeanor sex offense but this was regarding a couple and inappropriate behavior. Vandalism increased slightly, and this was primarily at a high school.

In response to Member Dieringer's inquiry regarding petty theft categorization, Captain Powers stated that those would fall under the category or misdemeanors, miscellaneous.

For RH, Captain Powers noted that there was one aggravated assault that was classified as a felony but was actually a misdemeanor domestic violence case. There was one structural burglary where the home owner had a shed outside that was broken into.

In response to Member Wilson regarding the meaning of the one forgery case, Captain Powers clarified that the count could be because it was reported in RH but not necessary done in the city itself.

Captain Powers reviewed the response times for each of the Peninsula cities and noted that he focused on numbers above 10. He explained that some factors that influence these response times could be that officers may not be hitting the button to stop the time as soon as they can.

In response to Chair Alegria regarding whether the Station tracks the trends from the cities, Captain Powers stated that they do track those. Chair Alegria suggested, with the Committee's agreement, that they begin tracking their own trends from the Peninsula, quarter over quarter for the past two years. Chair Alegria requested Analyst Lee to follow and provide an update for the next meeting.

In response to Member Bradley's inquiry regarding clarification of the column titles, Captain Powers defined that entry is when the dispatcher inputs the call, enroute is when the unit pushes the button on the computer going in route, arrival is when the unit has arrived at the scene, and tag is an identifier number stating which service number it was that day.

In response to Member Dieringer's inquiry regarding the one attempted kidnapping call, Captain Power explained that the actual incident is not necessarily what the call was for, as the dispatch inputs what they are told and believe the incident is in regards, but the actual incident may be different.

B. CONTRACT COMPLIANCE REPORT

Captain Powers provided a written staff report earlier and explained to the Committee that the Lomita Sheriff's Station would not be hiring additional brand new deputies. He stated that there are too many trainees and not enough training officers. Captain Powers explained that new deputy trainees have two months of training where their minutes do not count towards the contracts, which causes their Station's contract compliance percentage rate to drop.

C. MCCORMICK/PARADMEDIC RESPONSE UPDATE

Assistant City Manager Davis reviewed for the Committee that when some of the ambulance response times were over nine minutes, they found that this was due to the fact that other emergency responders such as the Sheriff's or Fire paramedics had already arrived. The data shown now displays the McCormick responses that were over nine minutes and the correlating Fire Department response times, as they had arrived earlier than McCormick and which is the true response time. Assistant City Manager Davis noted that every instance when McCormick has a response time over nine minutes the Fire Department had arrived sooner, as demonstrated in the yellow columns in the datasheet.

For RH's December 2019, Assistant City Manager Davis explained that the one large delay in McCormick's response was due to a traffic accident that blocked the gate at Palos Verdes Drive North and Portuguese Bend, and the subsequent inoperable gate. She noted that although there was a large delay in McCormick's response, Fire Department paramedics arrived in seven minutes.

In response to Member Dieringer's inquiry regarding if there are any statistics that show if people could have been saved if the responders arrived one minute faster or if deaths statistics are included. Chief Hale stated that those statistics are not tracked.

9. Other Matters from Regional Law Enforcement Committee Members

A. LAW ENFORCEMENT / STUDENT EDUCATION

Chair Alegria asked the Committee, on behalf of RPV Councilmember Dyda, if the SROs could provide student and the law education that had historically been done by the Sheriff's Station. Interim City Manager Mihranian also shared that Marymount California University has a program every semester where a deputy speaks on driver's safety. The Committee discussed the possibilities of this type of program, its benefits and drawbacks, if the Station or the District would be in charge, and what the cities would have to do if they would like to request this from PVPUSD. Chair Alegria suggested that this be placed as a future agenda item along with a SRO update.

Chair Alegria also mentioned the Flock security camera pilot program and wanted to provide an update for the Committee. In response to Member Dieringer regarding clarification of the Flock camera, Interim City Manager Mihranian explained that it is a solar powered camera similar to the ALPR that has higher quality resolution. City Manager Grammer shared that RHE has a Flock camera system piloted for a year and can provide an update on it for the next meeting.

Member Bradley requested the Committee to discuss inclusion of PVE, especially to target interface with different public safety agencies. The Committee discussed the historical decision, the contractual reasons, and previous inclusion activities of PVE for share programs such as the SRO and ALPR program.

Member Dieringer requested that the Committee receive an update regarding the expansiveness of the ALPR camera system as discussed earlier in the meeting.

10. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business before the Palos Verdes Peninsula Regional Law Enforcement Committee, Chair Alegria adjourned the meeting at 9:43 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled to be held on Thursday, May 14, 2020, following the Palos Verdes Peninsula Regional Emergency Preparedness Committee Meeting at 7:30 a.m. in the Council Chamber at Rolling Hills City Hall, 2 Portuguese Bend Road, Rolling Hills, CA 90274.

SUBJECT: FLOCK SAFETY CAMERA SYSTEM UPDATE

Flock Safety Camera System: Neighborhood Cameras

The cities of Rolling Hills Estates and Rancho Palos Verdes have worked with their respective Neighborhood Watch groups and Homeowners Associations (HOAs) to provide additional programs to further enhance public and personal safety. As a result, the City of Rolling Hills Estates staff has collaborated with the camera vendor Flock Safety and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department's Technology and Support Division including the Lomita Station this past year for a neighborhood camera pilot program.

The Flock Safety system has been determined to have high quality resolution with day and night functionality, motion detection imaging, and license plate reading technology that can be utilized by the local sheriff's station for police investigations and alerts. Although the Flock Safety system is in the early stages of alerting the local Lomita Sheriff's Station for wanted vehicles, it is not currently integrated into the greater Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department daily operations for county-wide data sharing. The camera is generally solar powered; however, can be hardwired if desired. The camera vendor has a cloud-based system in which a neighborhood representative can have administrative rights and access the system remotely. Staff has received positive feedback from Sheriff's Department personnel and neighborhood of overall system accessibility and functionality. As such, staff has recommended to City Council that this camera vendor be added to the City's camera grant vendor preferred list.

Additionally, the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will be piloting the camera system with an HOA this month for a total of five cameras that will be placed along the entrance/exit way of their neighborhood. Exhibit A: Flock Safety Camera and Pole Image



PVPUSD School Resource Officer (SRO) Update

The two School Resource Officers (SROs) for the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District (PVPUSD) have become an essential part of operations on campus. The School Resource Officers are working through the COVID-19 closure, of which became effective on March 13, 2020 for PVPUSD. Each SRO is patrolling our sites. In doing so, they are responding to calls about vandalism, gatherings of groups and routine checks to make sure the campus is secure and perimeter has not been breached allowing for accessibility. Officers Steve Moses and Dave Rozas continue conduct safety checks on the two comprehensive high school campuses and prior to the closure continued to attend school events with large crowds such as nighttime football games (both PV and Peninsula), basketball games, and school dances to ensure the safety of the students and faculty.

Both officers are conducting routine patrols at the elementary and middle school sites and are supplementing supervision staff with their presence to assist with difficult or confrontational situations. Their visual presence act as an effective deterrent, and them patrolling the sites is a huge reason they have not experienced more vandalism or break-ins. Specifically, Officer Moses is working 22 hours per week and Officer Rozas is working 26 hours per week, during the closure.

The PVPUSD summer program and curriculum offerings are still being finalized. There will be remote learning, however any discussion for on-campus summer instruction will be contingent on advisement from the County of Los Angeles. PVPUSD will send written confirmation as soon as their plan is finalized.
