Regular Services Provided to All Rolling Hills Residents



In Rolling Hills, we provide "scooter service" for all residents. Our drivers go onto the property to empty waste containers by hand into a "scooter truck," a small pickup truck with a special collection container in its bed. When full, the scooter truck returns to the large collection truck and offloads there.

Mixed Recycling and Waste

Recyclables and waste are collected in your mixed waste container. Please bag trash and leave recyclables loose. Mixed waste is taken to a materials recovery facility (MRF) for sorting.

Green Waste

Yard and landscaping waste, including grass clippings, leaves, tree and shrub trimmings, limbs, brush and similar items, are collected separately from mixed household waste. Place green waste into a container or bundle it (no more than 4 feet long).



Containers

You must provide your own containers. These should be no larger than 32 gallons. No container or bundle should weigh more than 60 pounds.

Designated Collection Location

Place containers in a location on your property that is visible to our drivers. If you change the location of your containers, please notify our team by emailing RollingHills@RepublicServices.com.

Schedule

Collection is provided twice each week to all residents. To find out the days of collection for your street, please contact Republic Services at **800.299.4898** or **RollingHills@RepublicServices.com**.

Other Services Available



On-Call Brush and Green Waste Collection

Republic Services provides on-call brush or green waste collection. Each residence may request one roll-off dumpster of up to a 40 cubic-yard capacity per calendar year at no additional cost. You will be responsible for loading the dumpster. If there is more brush or green waste than will fit inside the dumpster, Republic Services may charge you directly for collection service at the prescribed rate. Horse Manure Collection

If you have horses, please email Republic Services at **RollingHills@RepublicServices.com** to arrange for manure collection. There is a fee for this service.

Battery Recycling

Household batteries ONLY (AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt, button, etc.) are accepted outside of City Hall during normal business hours. NO batteries from power tools or automobiles are accepted.

Green Waste — Wednesday, March 8, 2023

Larger quantities of green waste will be collected near the roadside instead of at your typical designated collection location. Place the green waste in an area that is clearly visible to our drivers. Bundling makes for easier collection. Bundles should be no more than 4 feet long. No container, bag or bundle should weigh more than 60 pounds.

Bulk Items — Wednesday, March 15, 2023

Bulk items, such as furniture, appliances and rolled rugs, will be picked up from your designated collection location. Please place items in an area that is easily visible to our drivers. Set out items the night before collection or by 6 a.m. on the collection day.

Document Shredding and Electronic Waste Recycling — Saturday, March 25, 2023

Between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m., drop off confidential documents for secure shredding and electronic waste, such as computers, televisions, smartphones and similar items, for recycling at *City Hall*.
