February 05, 2019, 5:00 PM

CALLED MEETING:

Call to Order: The February 05, 2019 Regular Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor David L. Jordan at 5:00 p.m.

Attendance: Mayor David L. Jordan, Mayor Pro-Tem Keith Turman, Larry Bowen, Matt Fields, Wayne Braswell, Kenneth Roach, City Attorney Andrea Grant, City Manager Ed Andrews and Clerk Jan Pearson.

Additions or Deletions to Agenda: Approval of Fee Schedule added as B.

Approval of Agenda: Lee Strickland made a motion to approve agenda; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0.

New Business:

A. First Reading of Alcohol Ordinance:

- a. An ordinance amending Chapter 6 of the Royston Code of Ordinance regarding Alcoholic Beverage in reference to Distilled Spirits by-the-drink consumption on premises. Mayor confirmed reviewing and amending Chapter 6 Articles 1-5. Article 1 Sections 6-1 to 6-27 with 6-28 – 6-50 being reserved; Article 2: Malt Beverages and Wine Package Sales Sections 6-51-6-57 with Sec 6-58 – 6-130 Reserved;- Article 3 On Premises Consumption of Alcoholic Beverage Sections 6-131 – 6-140 with 6-141 – 6-180 reserved; Article 4 remains unchanged other than cleaning up language; Article 5 Wholesalers Sec 6-221 – 6-227 with 6-228 – 6-260 Reserved; Article 6 Farm Winery and Tasting Rooms, 7 Brew Pubs/Breweries, 8 Special Events have been reserved for future discussion aside from some basic language.
- b. Licensing process has been bolstered and a training process will be implemented to inform staff in city hall of all the requirements needed to provide a complete application packet to be reviewed by the City Attorney. City Manager emphasized this should streamline the process and save time and money in regards to the City Attorney's services.
- c. City Clerk will have authority to audit licensees and be sure the businesses are being straightforward with their information.
- d. Revisions and additions of Articles 6 – 8 will provide more opportunity to review any verbiage or other changes needed.
- e. Mayor reiterated the City Manager has done a thorough review of the Chapter 6 Ordinance. This ordinance will completely repeal and replace the previous ordinance. This constitutes the First Reading. Next meeting the City Attorney will have an enabling clause ready.

- B. Approval of Fee Schedule for Alcohol Licensing:** An update Fee Schedule for Alcohol Licensing was provided to the Council for review. The update is to be effective February 5, 2019 at midnight. Motion made to approve the fee schedule made by Wayne Braswell, motion seconded by Matt Fields. Motion carried 6-0.

Adjourn: Wayne Braswell made a motion to adjourn, Lee Strickland seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0. Meeting adjourned 5:10 p.m.
