

**The Salem Township Farm Preserve**  
Located on Salem Road between  
Five Mile and Brookville Road

*This preserve (235 acres) offers a diversity of rolling landscapes with threads of woodlands, wetlands and ponds. The land holds scenic views, abundant wildlife, agriculture and access trails. While visiting take time to enjoy the presence of the Johnson Creek with its high water quality and abundant aquatic wildlife. These lands are the headwaters of the Rouge water system which drains much of Southeastern Michigan. In the Spring and Fall take time to enjoy the migration of waterfowl and songbirds. View the many deer, wild turkey, visiting migrating waterfowl, and upland game birds that live upon this land.*

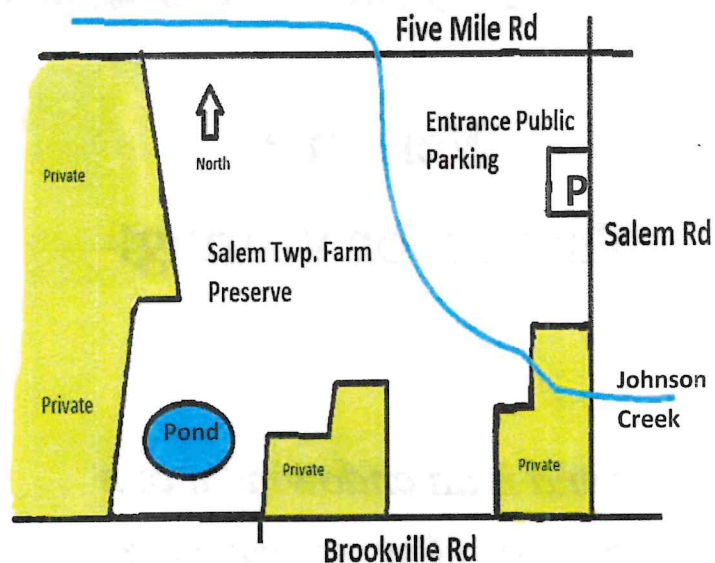

## Allowed Uses

- Walking/ Running
- Cross Country Skiing
- Bicycles
- Horse back riding (Walking only)
- Fishing “Catch & release only”
- Bird watching
- Nature Study
- Picnics
- Dogs must be “controlled” on a leash or radio controlled collar.
- All Dogs must be on a leash during the primary nesting season April 15 to July

## Prohibited Uses

- No Fires
- No Alcohol
- No Fireworks
- No Dumping
- No Hunting or Trapping
- No Target Shooting
- No Off road/motor Vehicles (Handicap vehicles are allowed)
- No Camping
- No Wood Cutting
- No radios or “Boom Boxes”
- No Trespassing on Farm Land
- No Parties
- No Collecting (Flowers, rocks.)
- No Swimming or Boating



**Parking only in designated area.**

**Stay on Marked Trails** Protect Plants and crops nesting areas.

**Stay away from nearby homes**

Respect privacy.

**Respect Wildlife** Keep wildlife wild, observe from a distance.

**Leave No Trash** Pick up all your trash – Leave only footsteps.
