## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

## SCHWARTZ HANGAR

Shirley Schwartz family member of the Frankie Schwartz Estate was in attendance and spoke to the Airport Board concerning the status of lease and ownership of hangar by the late Frankie Schwartz. Also mentioned aircraft occupied in the hangar has been sold but not removed. Tyler Naramore offered she contact her estate representative and city attorney to discuss the status of lease agreements.

**NEW HANGAR PROJECT** 

Mark Nash mentioned new hangar construction is on track to be finished July 2023.

**GATE OPENER**

**PILOT LOUNGE** 

Tyle Naramore mentioned the need for air conditioning for the pilot Lounge. Very hot in summer months. A window unit would be needed.

## **ROUTINE AIRPORT MAINTENANCE**

Tyle mentioned routine maintenance for the removal of rocks on taxi way and runways, dirt piles and boulders on runway and taxiway shoulders. Also, mosquitos are quite annoying in morning and late afternoons. Suggested spraying or drainage of water accumulation on north side of aircraft tie down area.

## **OTHER BUSINESS**

Tyler discussed a need for an electric calendar so pilots can make reservations for the courtesy car. Decision was made that pilots using the courtesy car will be on a first come first serve basis until more information needed for a reservation system.

Tyler requested improvement needed for hangar #6. Needs ground work leveling with concrete surface for moving aircraft in/out of hangar. Mark Nash will follow up with information for what may be needed.
