

SANFORD TRANSFER STATION **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Regular Operating Hours for the Transfer Station and Debris Area: Tuesday thru Friday 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM, Saturday 7:30 AM to 12:00 PM (Noon)

Any changes in these hours will be posted on our website at www.sanfordmaine.org, at the Sanford Transfer Station and Sanford Public Works Department.

The Transfer Station and Debris Area will be **CLOSED** on Holidays and Tuesdays following a Monday Holiday to include: Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Patriot's Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Labor Day and Columbus Day. For any other Holidays, please check the City's website at www.sanfordmaine.org or call the Sanford Transfer Station at (207)324-9144 or Sanford Public Works Department 324-9140.

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RESIDENTIAL PERMITS Sold to residents for use of the facility to bring waste/debris from their **own residence only**. Cost: \$5.00 per permit, plus the cost of items disposed of in the Debris Area. Only Cash and Checks are accepted. (Please see Environmental Fee Schedule <https://www.sanfordmaine.org/environmental>). Each vehicle a resident uses to bring material to the transfer must have a current permit. If you borrow a vehicle that is not registered in Sanford/Springvale you must bring proof of residency (driver's license, light bill, phone bill or something with your address) and obtain a temporary permit.

COMMERCIAL WASTE HAULING BUSINESSES may only use the facility for deposit of PAYT bags. The business using the Facility must have a current permit issued at the Transfer Station (Cost: \$5.00) and a Waste Haulers License from the City of Sanford, City Clerk's Office. Waste Hauling Businesses are permitted to dispose of waste generated by Residences located within the City of Sanford/Springvale only with City approved **ORANGE PAY-AS-YOU THROW BAGS**.

Commercial Businesses are not permitted to dispose of Recycling or use the Demo Debris Area.

MUTI-UNIT OWNERS (5 or more Units) An application is submitted and approved by the Director of Public Works. Cost: \$100.00 per permit/location of property. All recycling must be accompanied by orange PAYT bags generated from the same location(s). All orange PAYT bags and recycling must be from a single location only per trip exclusively. Based on the amount of recycling received, the City reserves the right to discontinue your use of the Transfer Station at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.

If you have more than one vehicle, each vehicle you use to bring materials to the transfer must have a current permit.

The registration for each vehicle obtaining a transfer permit must be presented when applying. Only vehicles with a Sanford/Springvale registration may obtain a permit. All permits shall be good from July 1st through June 30th of the following year and must be affixed to the lower driver's side of the windshield, placed by the attendant.

****ALL HOUSEHOLD TRASH MUST BE IN CITY OF SANFORD/SPRINGVALE APPROVED ORANGE PAY-AS-YOU-THROW BAGS. ****

All vehicles obtaining Residential permits will be measured and charged accordingly for material delivered to the Debris Area. Only Waste/Debris from Sanford/Springvale may be disposed of at the Sanford Waste Transfer Station. It is the responsibility of the person obtaining a permit to assure that only Sanford/Springvale MSW/Recycling/Debris is taken to the Sanford Transfer Station.

IF THE RULES FOR DISPOSING WASTE/DEBRIS AT THE SANFORD TRANSFER STATION ARE VIOLATED, DUMPING PRIVILEGES MAY BE REVOKED.

Permits are non-transferable and fees are no-refundable. If you trade your vehicle, remove the permit, surrender it to the attendant and it will be replaced at no cost. If you do not surrender the permit, you must purchase another one for the new vehicle.

SOLID WASTE MATERIALS MUST BE DUMPED IN LOCATIONS DESIGNATED BY THE CITY AND DISPOSAL FEES MUST BE PAID ON CERTAIN WASTES.

IN ALL CASES, THE WORD OF THE ATTENDANT IS FINAL. THEY HAVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY AND ALL ITEMS.

DEBRIS AREA

1. No hazardous material of any kind will be accepted.
2. All debris must be separated and placed in designated areas per attendant.
3. Large amounts of wire, cable and other loose light iron should be placed inside clean drums.
4. Paint cans must be empty and dry to be accepted. Any cans containing paint will not be accepted.
5. Large ferrous items such as junk automobiles, boats, underground fuel tanks etc. will not be accepted.
6. Computers, televisions, fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, rechargeable batteries, and anything with mercury must be recycled. Fees may apply.
7. The attendant's word is final on all disposal and charges.

ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE PROHIBITION OF A RESIDENT FROM ENTERING THE TRANSFER STATION FACILITY.
