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Shall the City of Sanford authorize the Treasurer and the Mayor to issue general obligation securities of the City, including temporary notes in anticipation of the sale thereof, in an aggregate maximum principal amount not to exceed \$42,500,000, plus any additional premium, for the purpose of funding the construction of two new fire stations, including engineering, site work and other costs reasonably related thereto; and delegate to the Treasurer and the Mayor the discretion to fix the date(s), maturity (ies), interest rate(s), denomination(s), calls for redemption (with or without premium) place(s) of payment, form, refundings, and other details of said securities, including execution and delivery of said securities on behalf of the City of Sanford, to provide for the sale thereof and to expend bond proceeds on the project.

CITY OF SANFORD FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The issuance of bonds by the City of Sanford (the "City") is one of the ways in which the City borrows money for certain purposes. The following is a summary of the bonded indebtedness of the City as of this Referendum:

When money is borrowed by issuing bonds, the City must repay not only the principal amount of the bonds but also any interest on the bonds. The amount of interest to be paid will vary depending upon the rate of interest and the years to maturity at the time of issue
