
2040 Comprehensive General Plan Update (Planning)

2040 Comprehensive General Plan Update

RECOMMENDATION

- There is no action required at this time. Following this study session, unless a subsequent study session is requested, staff will return to the City Council at a Special City Council meeting on February 8, 2022, seeking approval for the 2040 Comprehensive General Plan update and Final Environmental Impact Report.

BACKGROUND

Following the City Council meeting on February 1, 2022, which was preceded by study sessions on January 18, 2022 and January 24, 2022, after considering information provided by Staff and comments from the general public, the City Council directed staff to schedule another study session and engage with property and business owners who have expressed concerns over proposed changes.

At this study session, staff will provide an update on the discussions with property and business owners and present options for the General Plan update for consideration by the City Council.
