## NOVEMBER 5, 2024 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

The City of Santa Fe Springs is governed by a five-member City Council whose members are elected at large. Elections are held during even-numbered years, and the next General Municipal Election will be held on November 5, 2024. Two (2) City Council seats will be eligible for election.

The nomination period for candidates is scheduled from **July 15, 2024 – August 9, 2024**. During the nomination period, you can obtain official nomination papers from the City Clerk's Office. The City Clerk's Office will begin taking calls to schedule appointments starting July 1, 2024.

Residents may register to vote at any time. If a qualified

voter is not registered to vote and wants to vote, the voter must register at least 15 days before the election. Voter registration requirements include:

- A United States citizen and a resident of California
- 18 years old or older on Election Day
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court
- Not currently serving a state or federal prison term for the conviction of a felony

Deadline to register to vote: October 21, 2024



## July Fireworks Safety Tips... *Keep it Legal, Keep it Safe*



The City of Santa Fe Springs would like to remind everyone to celebrate safely this Fourth of July! The following City Rules & Regulations and Safety Tips are provided to ensure that you and your families have a safe and enjoyable Independence Day.

**Illegal Fireworks Are Dangerous. The following examples are illegal and prohibited:**



**“ZERO TOLERANCE” FOR ILLEGAL FIREWORKS. Violators in possession of, discharging or distributing illegal fireworks are subject to fines of \$1,000.**

If you have any questions or need to obtain more information, please contact the Police Services Center at (562) 409-1850. To report illegal fireworks activity, contact the Whittier Police Department at (562) 567-9240.

### City Rules & Regulations:

- Only “Safe & Sane” fireworks containing the U.S. Fire Marshal seal of approval may be sold, purchased and discharged in the City.
- Fireworks may only be sold and discharged during the period beginning 12:00 p.m. on June 30th, ending at 12:00 a.m. on July 5th.
- It is illegal to possess or discharge fireworks on City property, including City parks.
- Citations will be issued to those who possess, discharge or distribute illegal fireworks. Violators are subject to fines of \$1,000 for each violation.

### Safety Tips When Using “Safe & Sane” Fireworks:

- Do not modify any fireworks. Fireworks modification can result in serious injuries.
- Always read directions and use common sense.
- Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol.
- Keep fireworks at a safe distance and away from structures, areas of dry vegetation and flammable substances.
- Fireworks should be discharged from a hard surface such as concrete, gravel or pavement.
- Adult supervision is vital anytime fireworks are being ignited or handled.
- Don’t allow children to pick up left over pieces of fireworks. Some may still be ignited and can explode at any time.
- Do not attempt to relight or fix malfunctioning fireworks.
- Soak all fireworks in a bucket of water before throwing them in the trash can.
- Think about your pet(s). Animals have sensitive ears and can be extremely frightened or stressed due to the noise. Keep pets indoors to reduce the risk that they’ll run loose or get injured.
- Do your part by removing left over trash from discharged fireworks. This helps keep pollutants out of the storm drain system.

## Wading Pool Hours



The Parks & Recreation Department invites family and friends for a cool and fun time at your neighborhood wading pools located at Lakeview Park, Little Lake Park, Los Nietos Park, and Santa Fe Springs Park. Wading Pools will be open, weekdays 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m. and weekends 12:30 p.m.- 5:30 p.m., starting May 4th. Wading Pools will be open daily, 12:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m. June 8-August 19 (July 3 all wading pools closed except Los Nietos Park). Children under 5 MUST be accompanied by an adult in the pool at all times. Swimsuits and swim trunks are required to enter the pool and this is strictly enforced. Rash guard-style shirts are allowed. Undergarments and other clothing are not allowed in the wading pools. Swim diapers are required for toddlers and are available for purchase from the park staff for \$3. Water shoes are also available for purchase for \$8. Join us for a cool night of swimming from 5:30 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. at our wading pools on Tuesday and Thursday evenings starting June 11. Check with your local park for dates.






